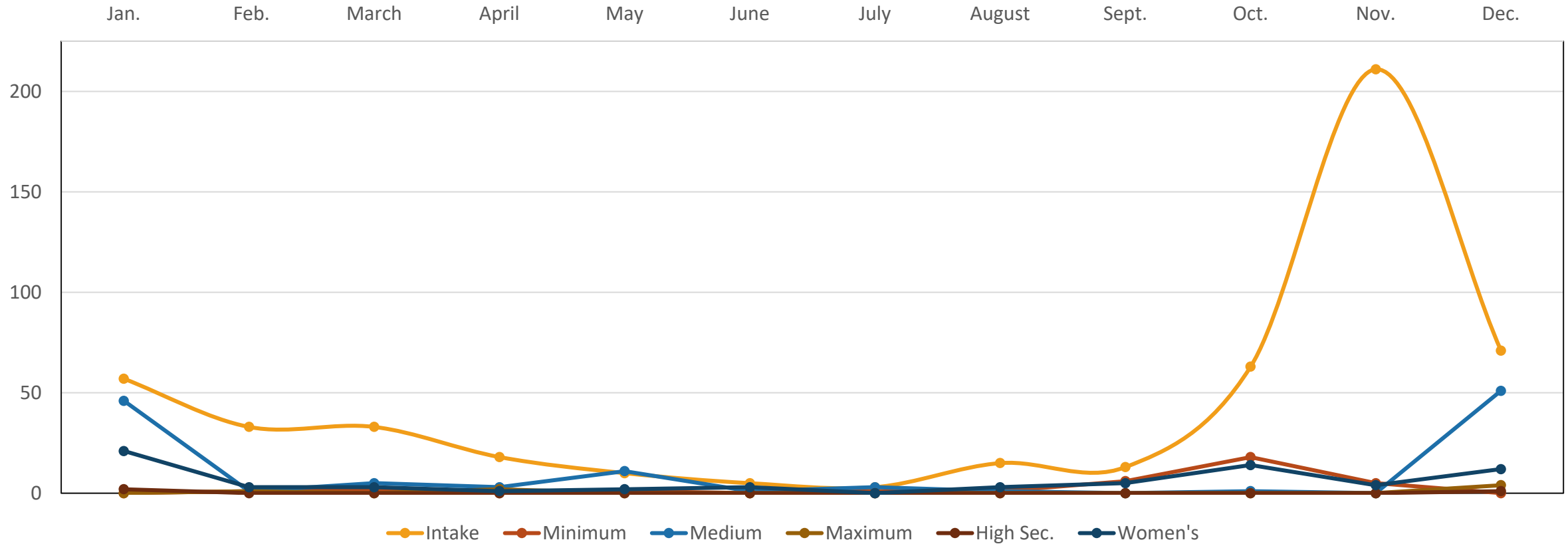

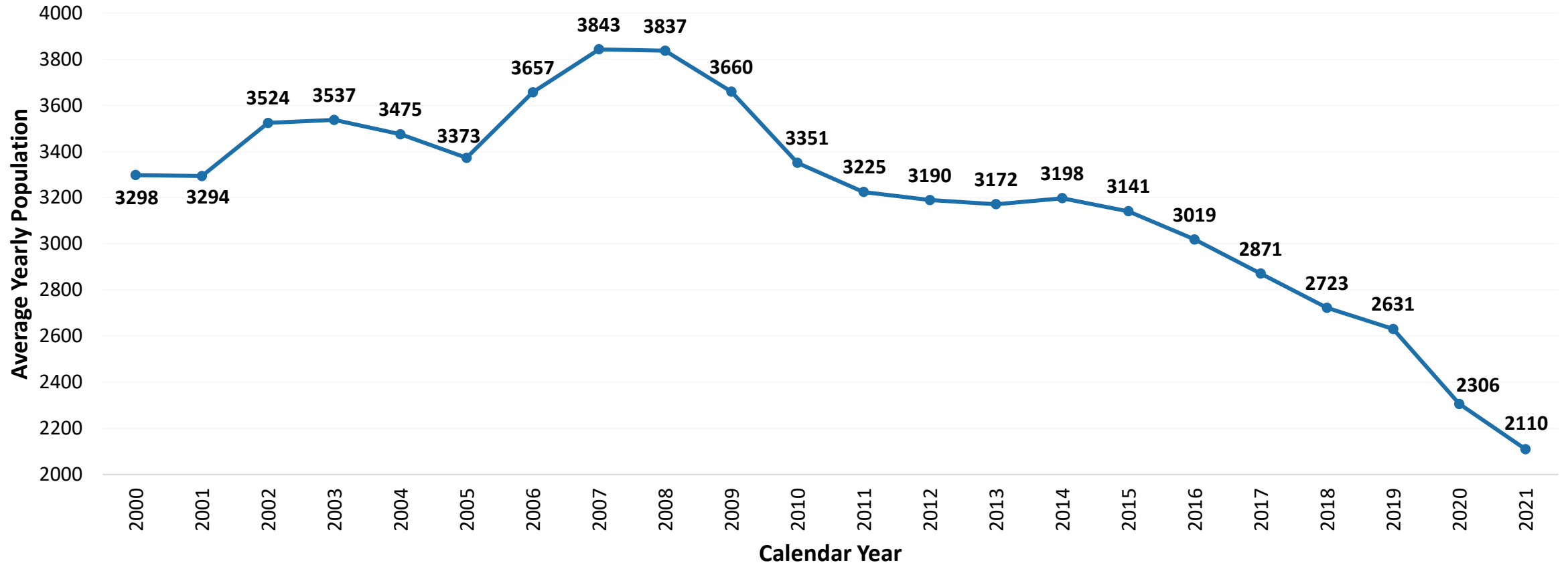

# COVID-19 CASES BY FACILITY CALENDAR YEAR (CY) 2021



- COVID-19 cases remained stable throughout the first half of CY21. In October and November 2021, there was a noteworthy spike in cases at RIDOC's Intake Service Center that aligned with COVID-19 trends in the community. Intake Service Center processes all new male commitments. As a result, its offender population is highly transient and susceptible to COVID-19 related spikes. These spikes are attributed to the prevalence of variants in the community. RIDOC has implemented a comprehensive COVID-19 mitigation strategy to protect the health and wellness of staff and offenders.

# Average Total Population CY00 – CY21

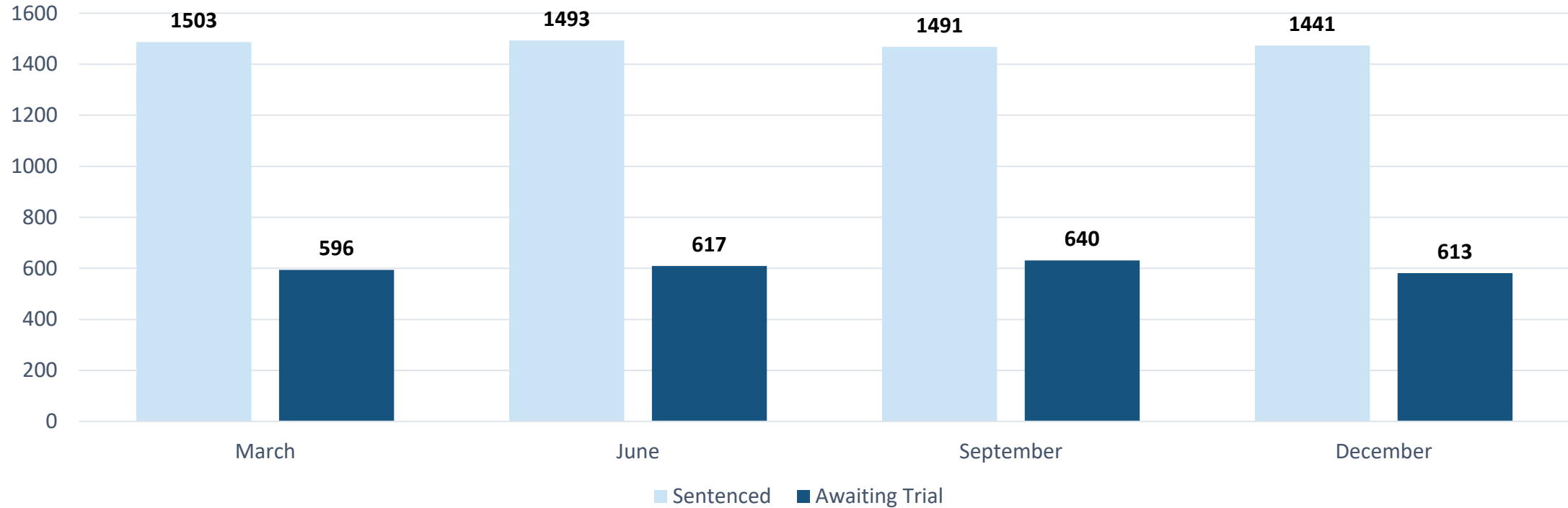


➤ RIDOC's average total population in CY21 was 2,110, yielding an 8.5% decline from RIDOC's CY20 population (2306).

\*Data Caveat: Please note *RIDOC's average total population excludes offenders who are held/serving a RI sentence out-of-state in accordance with the Interstate Compact at the Eleanor Slater Hospital Forensic Unit, or who are on Home Confinement.*

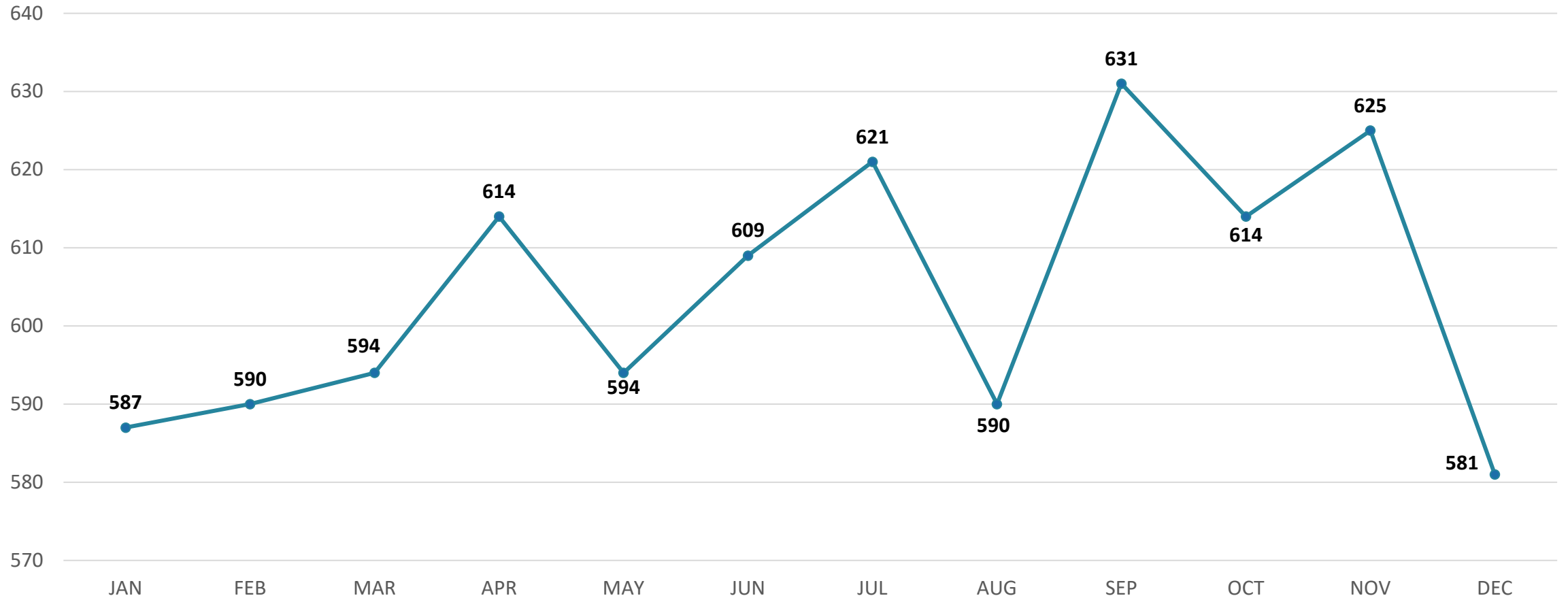
# Awaiting Trial & Sentenced Quarterly Stock Population CY21

Quarterly Stock Sentenced Awaiting Trial & Sentenced Population CY21



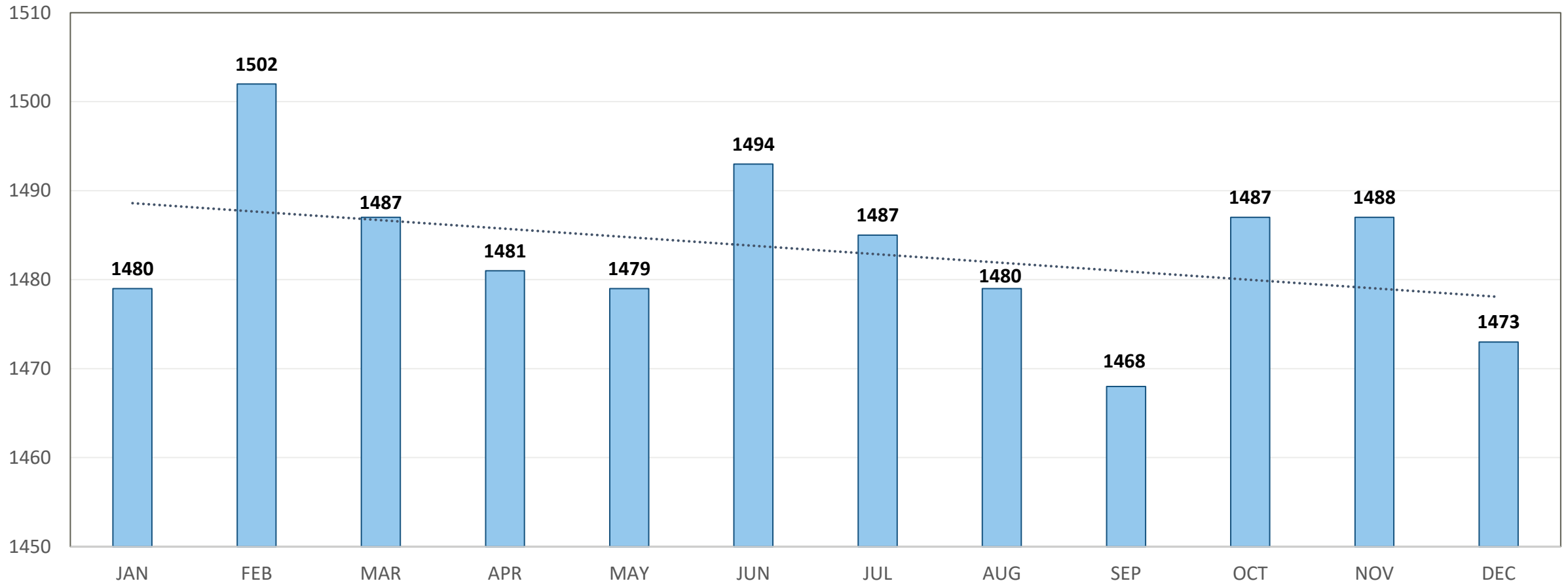
- The average monthly sentenced population for CY21 was 1,484 and the average monthly awaiting trial population was 604.

## Average Monthly Awaiting Trial Population CY21



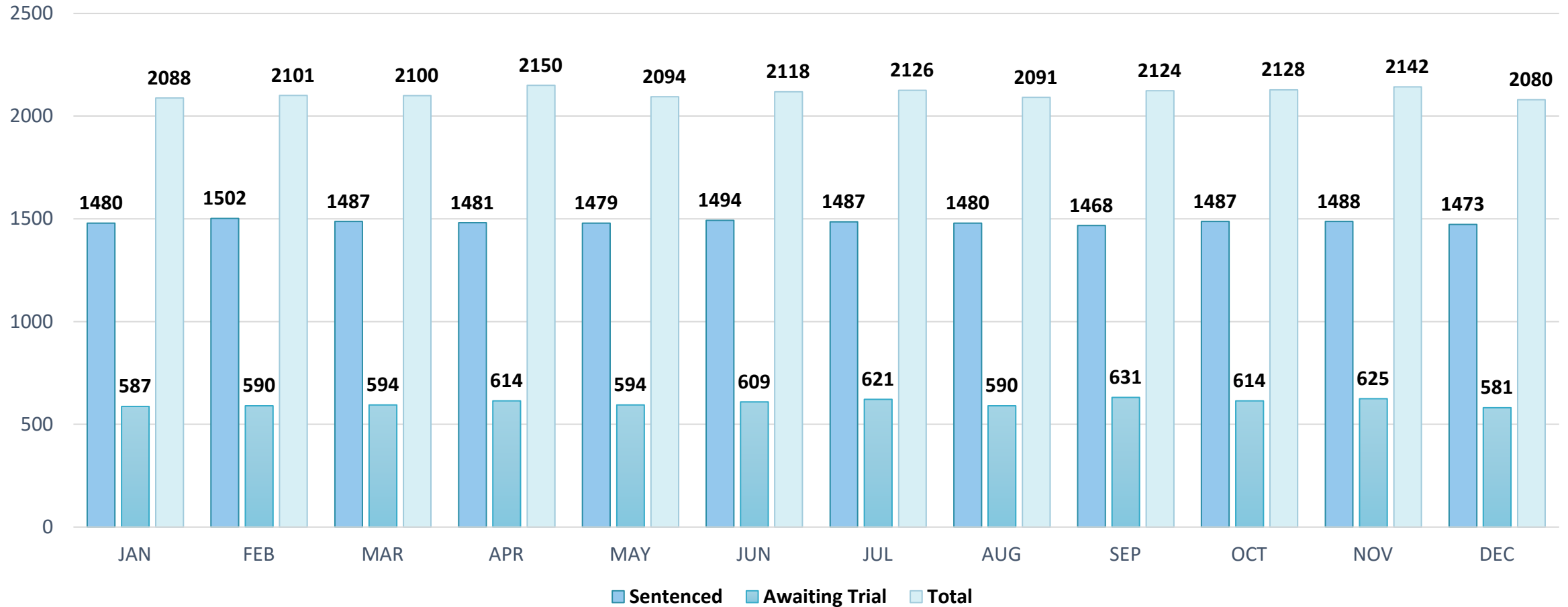
- RIDOC's average awaiting trial population in CY21 (604) increased by 2.7% from CY20 (588).

➤ RIDOC's average sentenced population in CY21 (1,484) yielded a 12.6% decline from CY20(1,698).

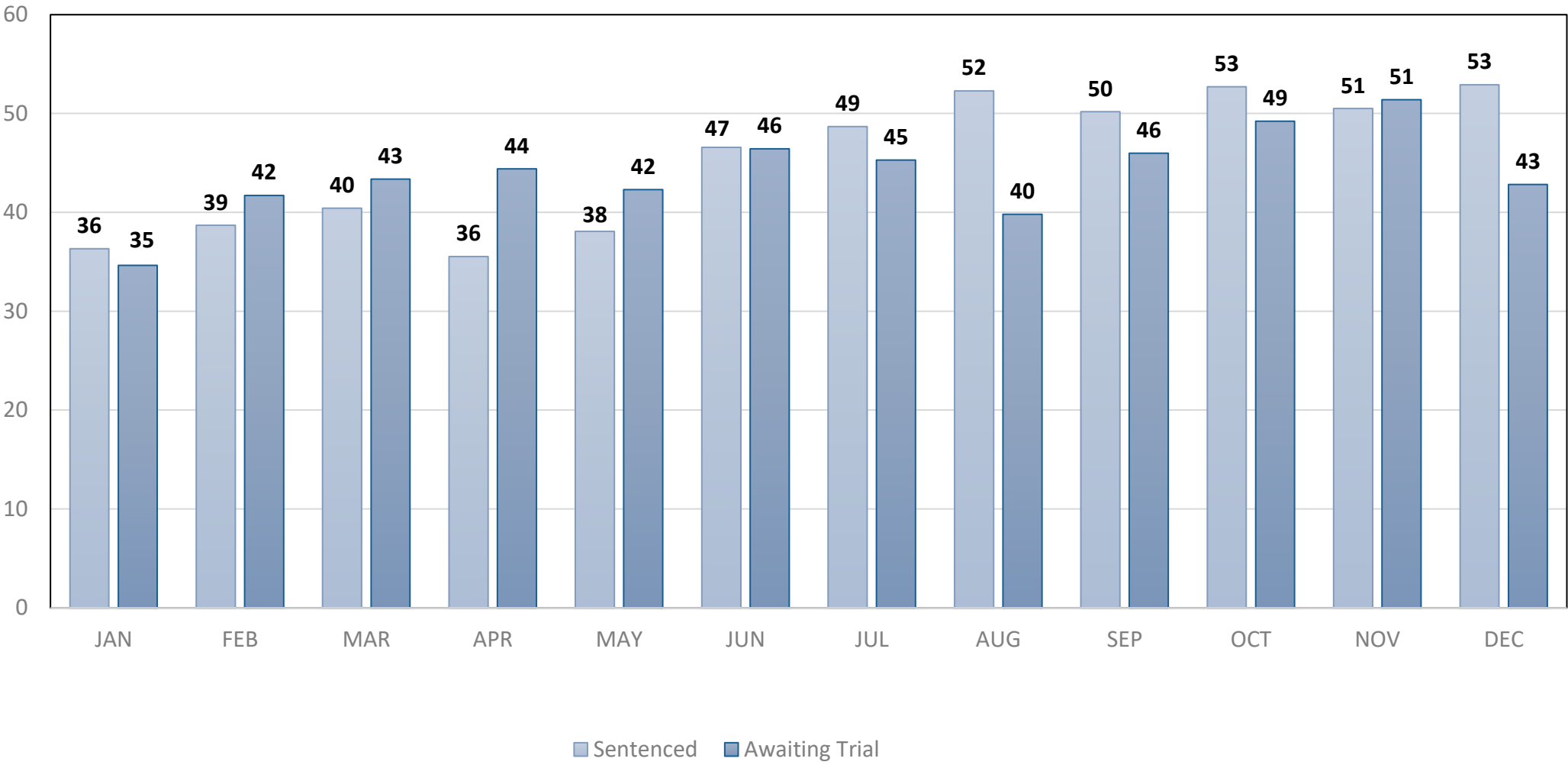
# Average Monthly Sentenced and Awaiting Trial Population CY21



- RIDOC's average monthly sentenced population for CY21 was 1,484 and the average monthly awaiting trial population was 604.

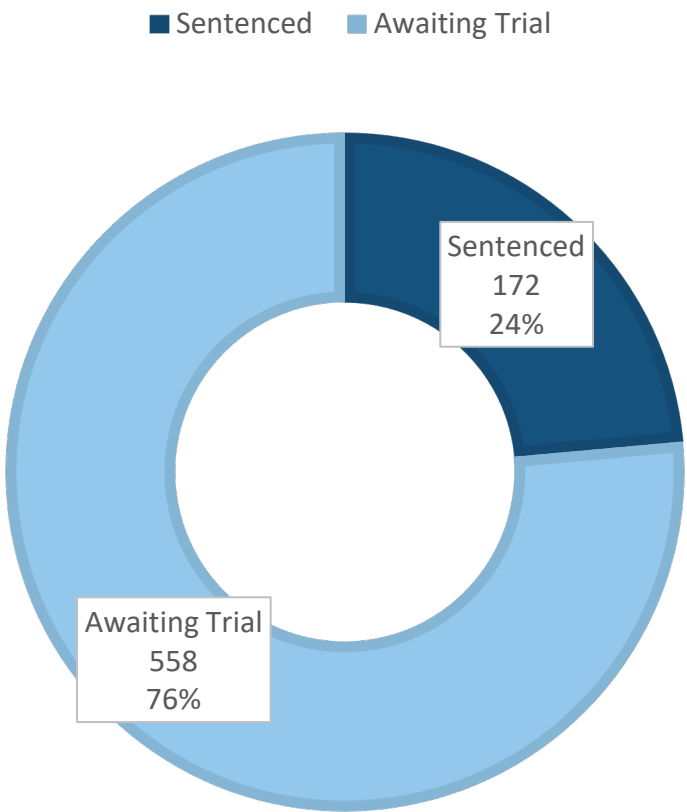
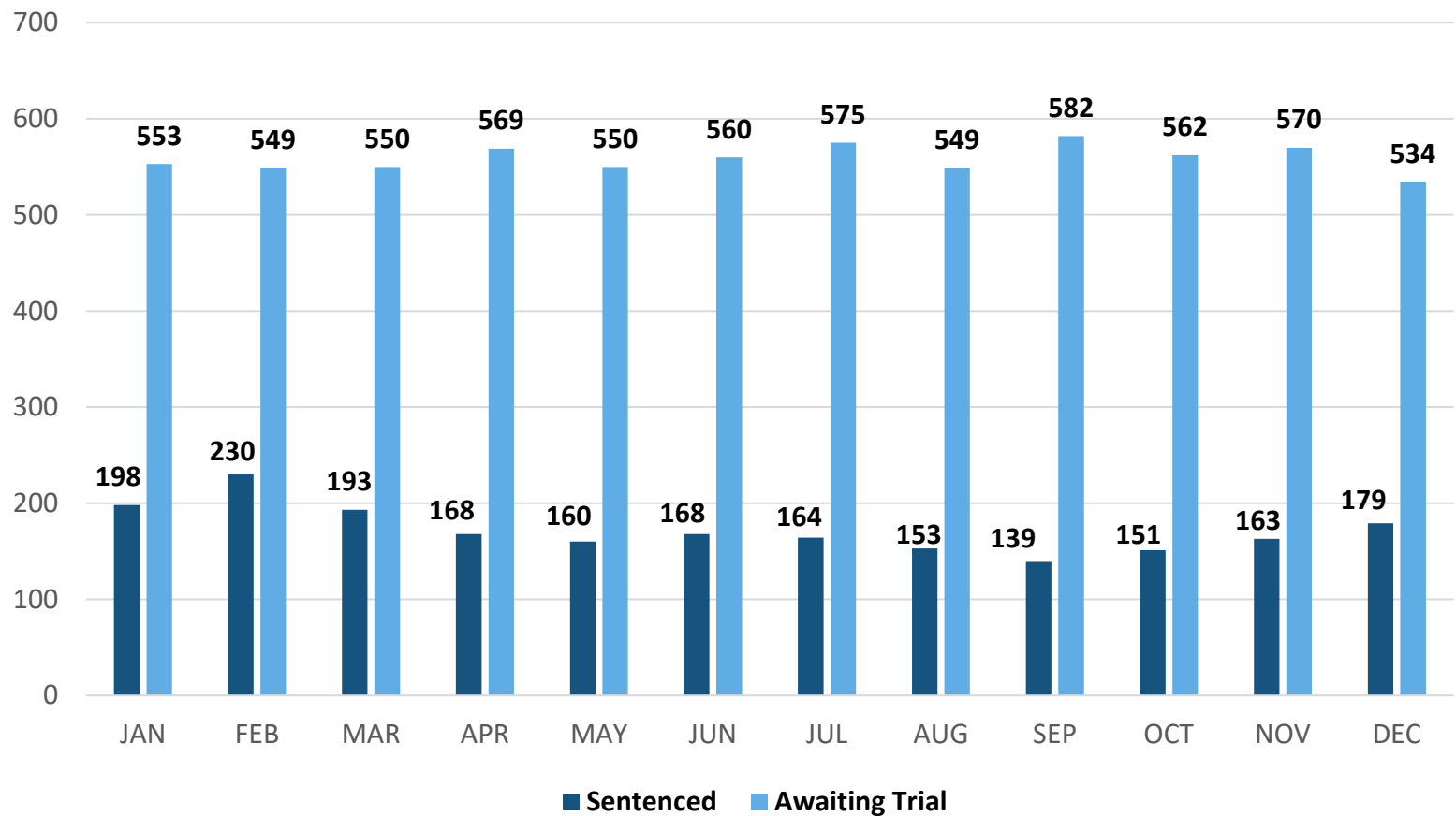

# Intake Service Center (ISC) Average Monthly Population by Status & Breakdown CY21



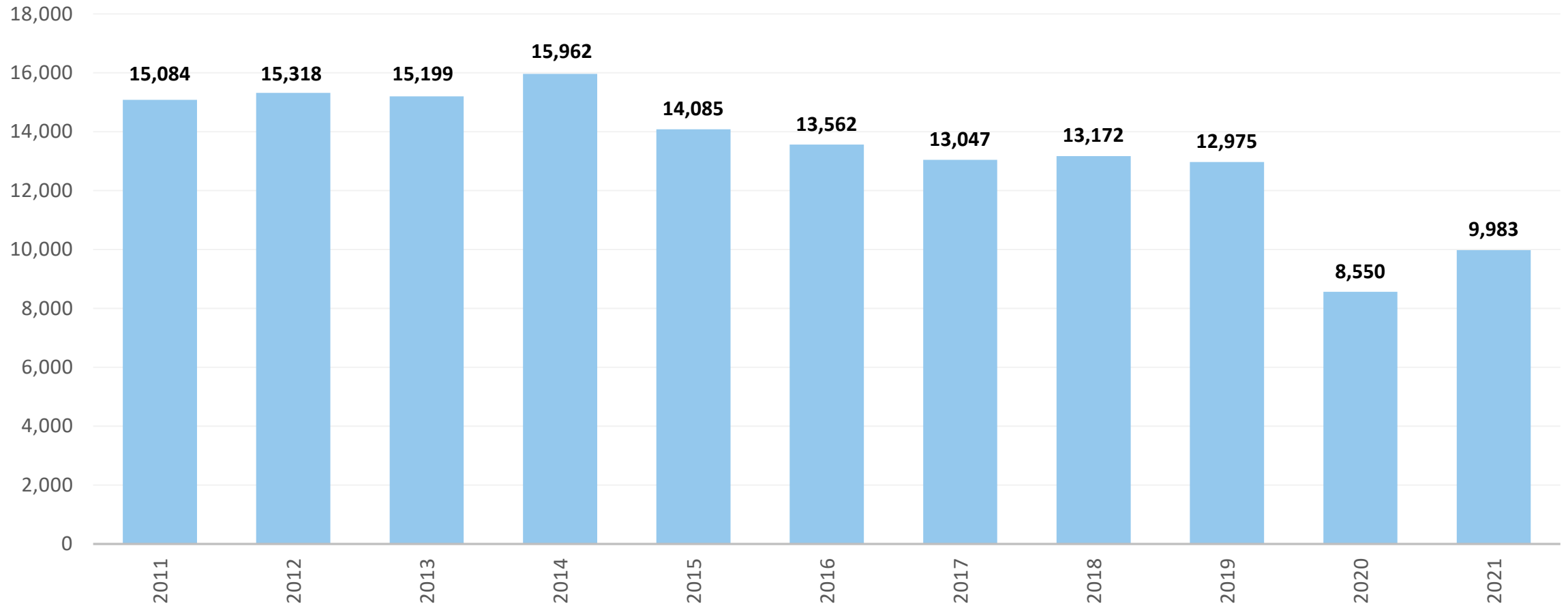
➤ RIDOC’s ISC holds both awaiting trial and sentenced inmates. In CY21 the ISC average monthly awaiting trial population was 558 (76%) and the average monthly sentenced population was 172 (24%).

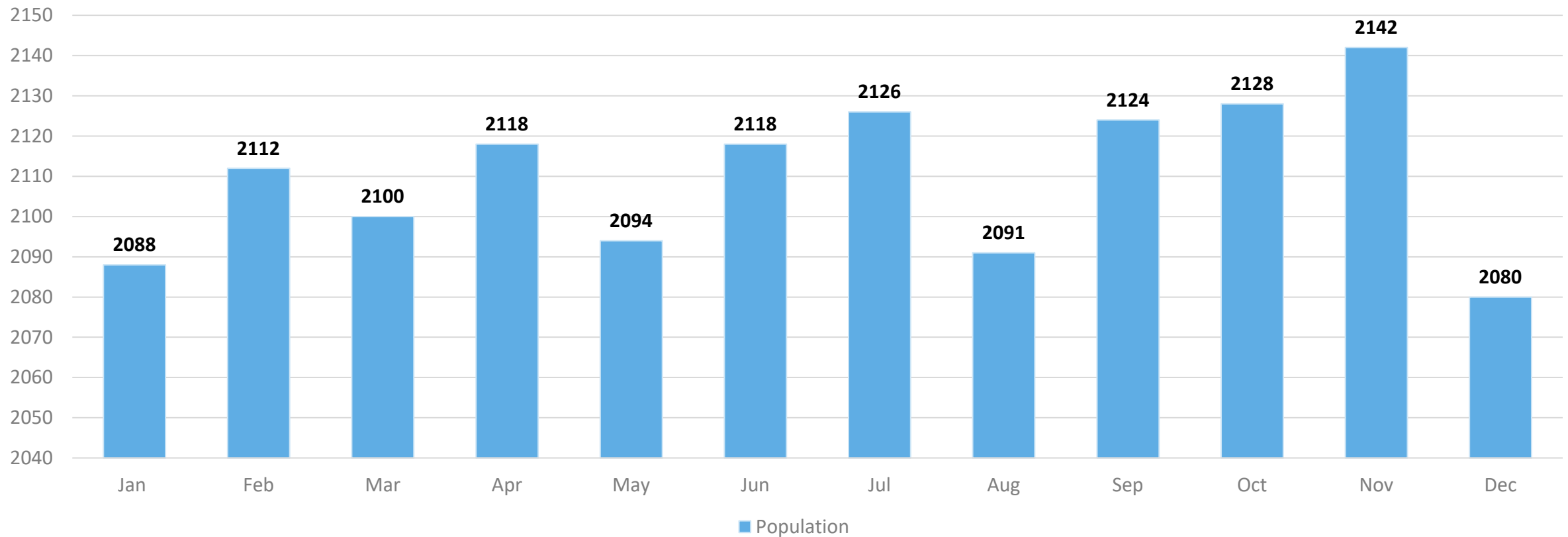
- From CY11 to CY21, RIDOC's commitments have decreased by 34%. The impact of COVID-19 on RIDOC's commitment stream was first recorded in early CY20. In comparing CY20 to CY21, RIDOC commitments had decreased by 16.76%.

## Commitments by Calendar Year CY11-CY21



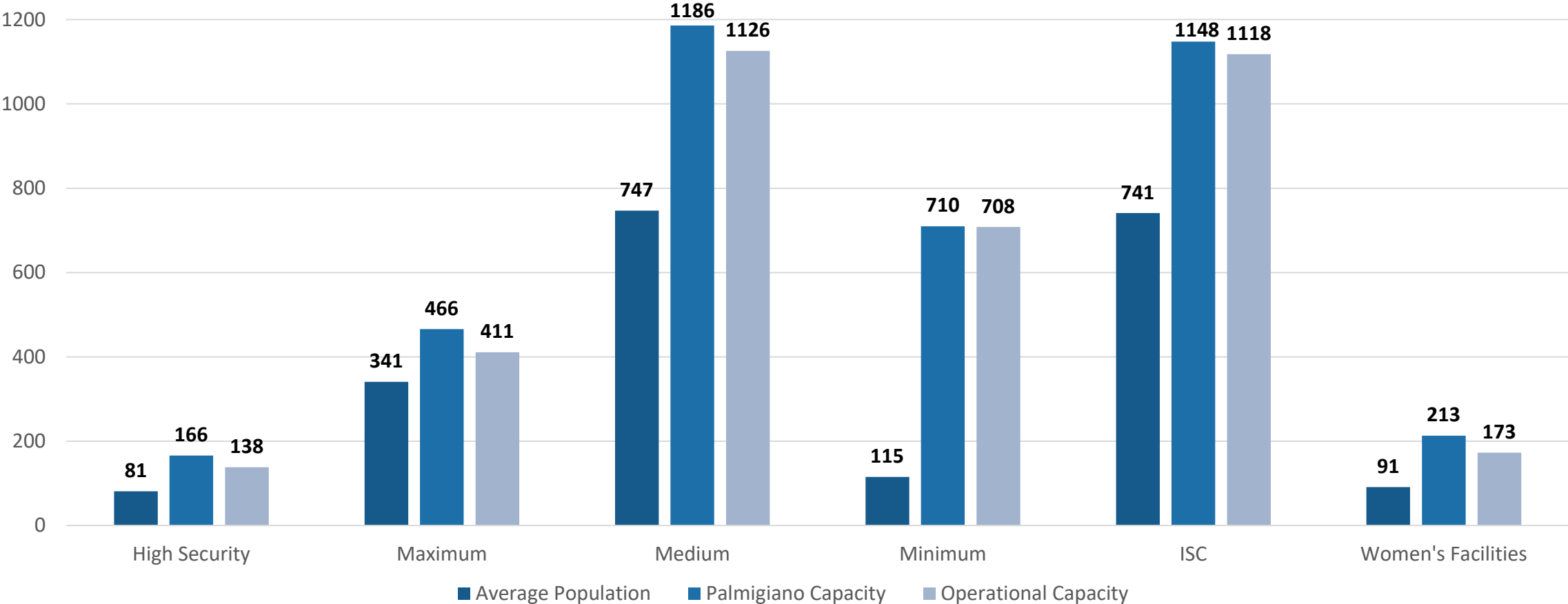
➤ RIDOC's total commitments for CY21 was 9,983, a 16.8% increase from CY20 (8,550).

## Average Monthly Total Population with *Palmigiano* and Operational Capacities CY21



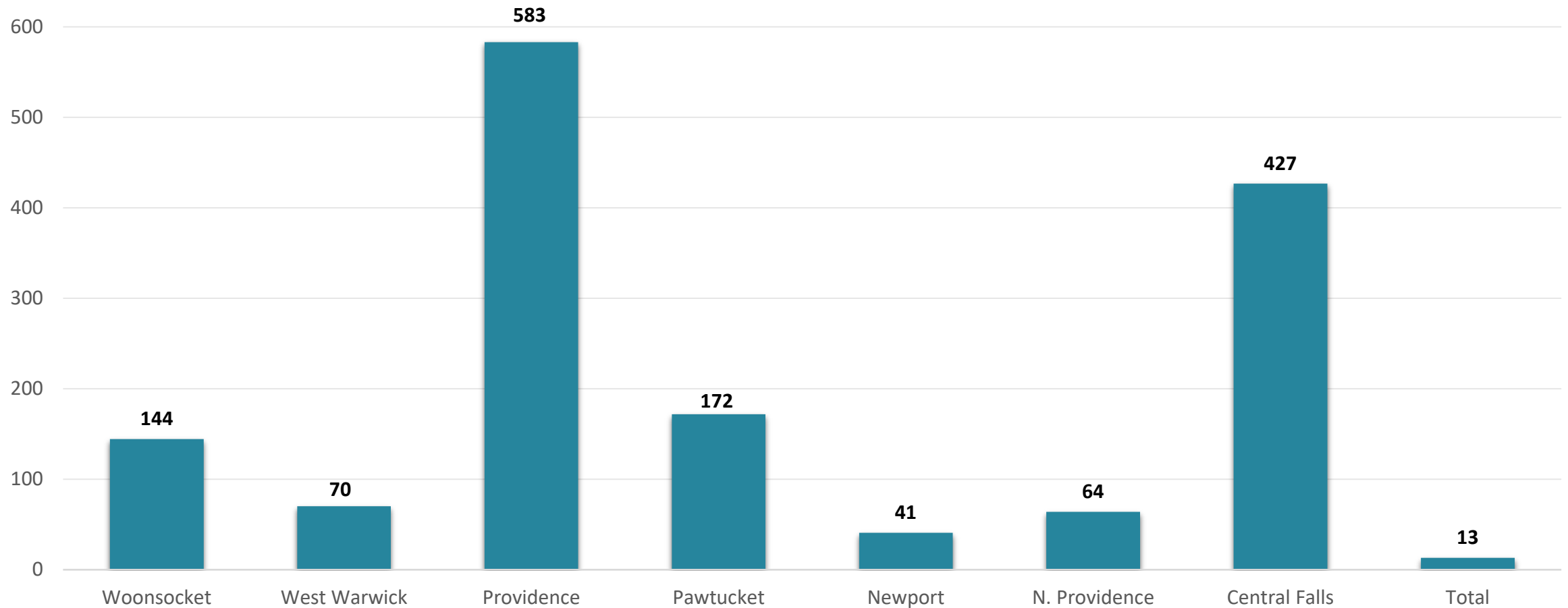
- RIDOC's average total population for CY21 was 2,080. This is 61% of RIDOC's Operational Capacity and 57.8% of the *Palmigiano* Capacity.

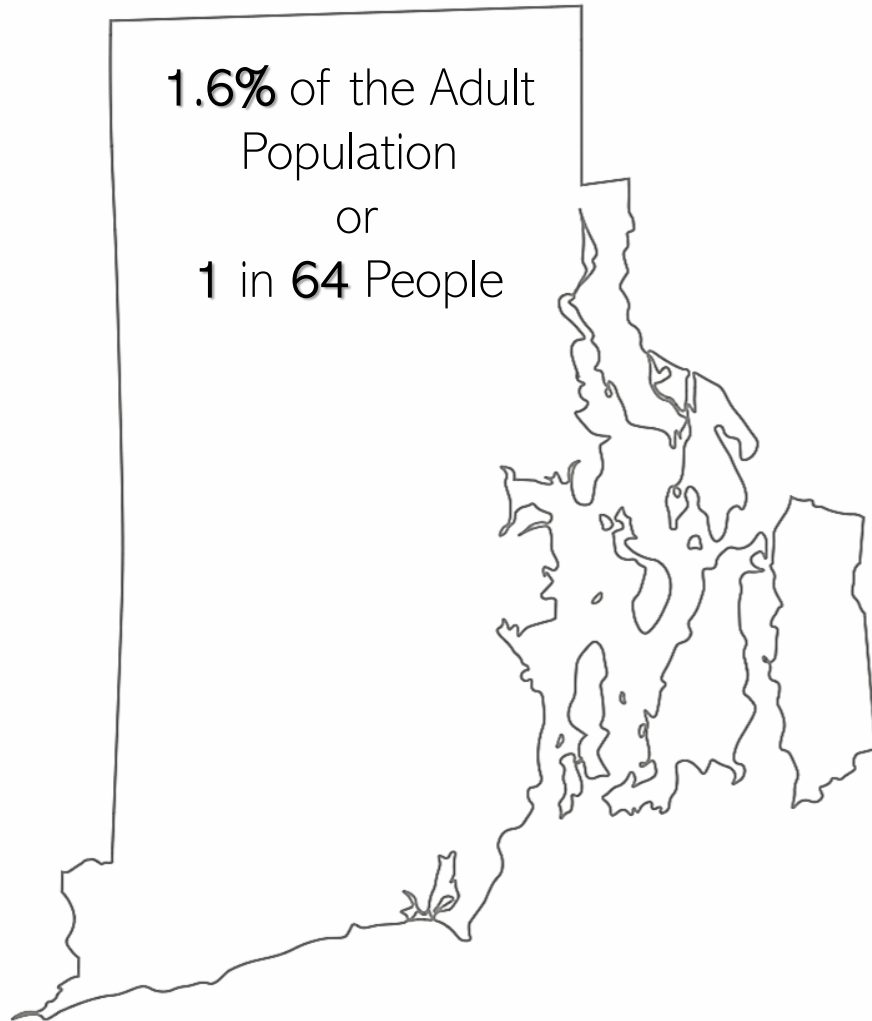
## Rhode Island Probation and Parole Offenders: Living in Rhode Island Communities Per Square Mile as of 09/30/2021

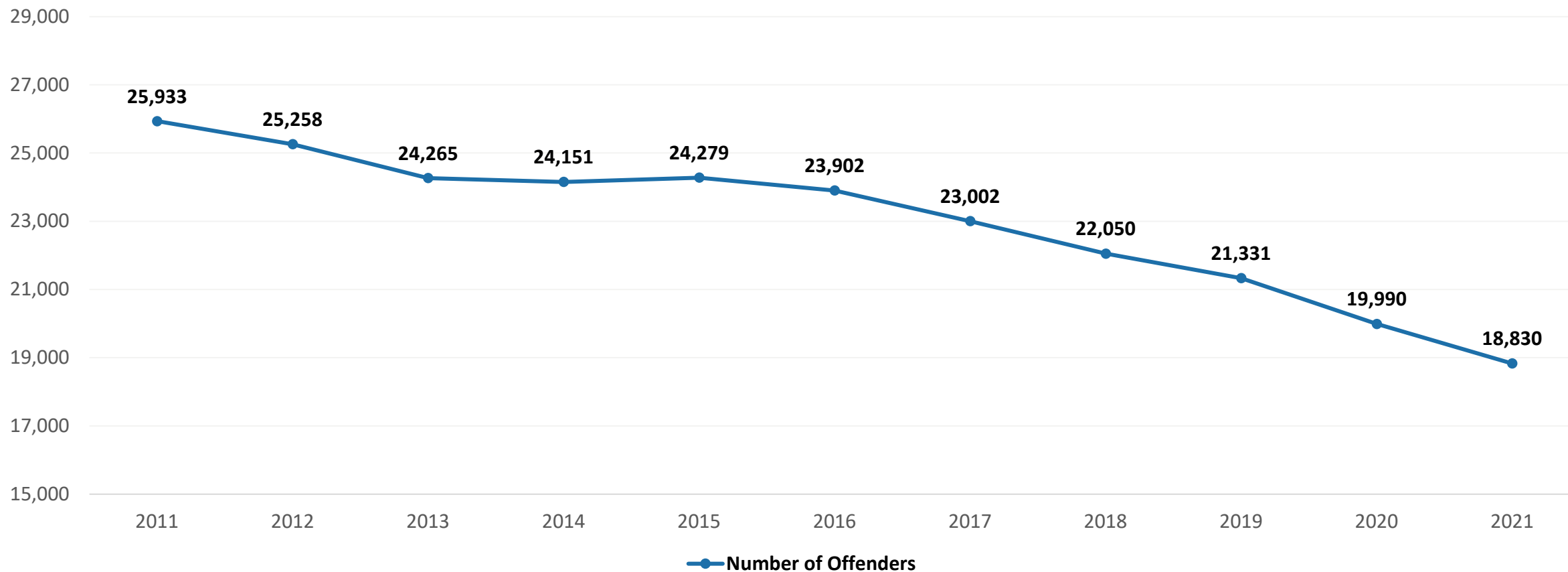

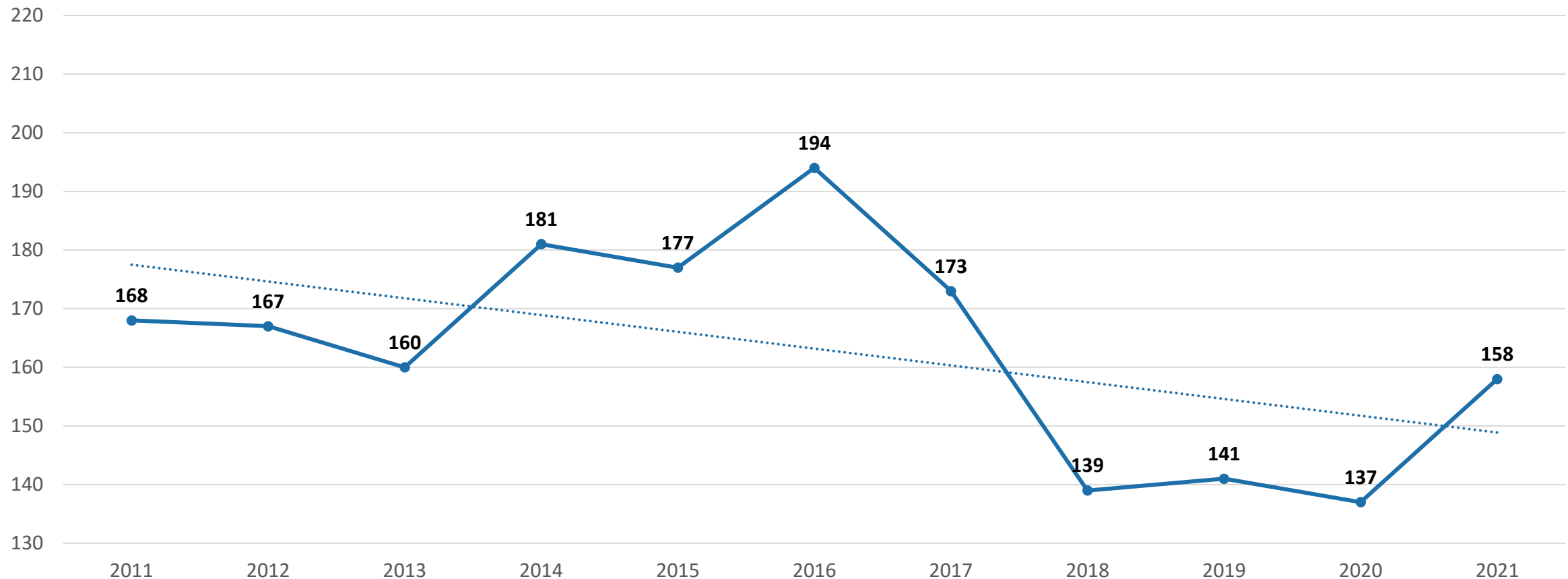
# Average Total Probation & Parole Population CY11-CY21



- As of September 30th, 2021, there were 18,830 RI offenders on adult probation and parole.
- Of those, 2,663 were on Active Probation, 276 on Active Parole, 1,368 currently incarcerated in Rhode Island and 62 currently incarcerated out of state.



# Average Total Home Confinement Population by Year



➤ Home Confinement has fluctuated over the past ten years. There has been an overall 6% decrease from CY11 to CY21.

# Rhode Island Inmates Serving Life

- As of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021: 202 offenders are currently serving life with the possibility of parole. Of those 202:
  - 19 are currently serving out of state.
  - 46% of these offenders are currently housed at Maximum Security.
  - There has been a 3.5% increase in the number of offenders serving life since CY20.
  
- As of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021: 31 offenders are currently serving life without parole. Of those 31:
  - 4 are currently serving out of state.
  - 68% of these offenders are currently housed at Maximum Security.
  - There has been no change in the number of offenders serving life without parole since CY20.
