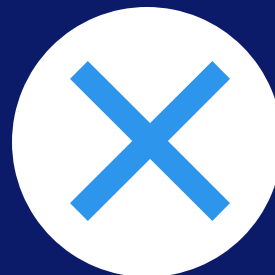




You have been on probation in the community for at least 3 years



During the past 3 years, you have NOT been declared by the court to be a violator



There is NO active no-contact order against you as part of your probation



You have completed the terms and conditions of your probation and paid ALL fines in full

Rule 35(c) of the R.I. Superior Court Rules was recently changed to allow someone serving probation in the community to **seek approval** from the Superior Court to end their probation early **if several criteria are met.**

# END YOUR PROBATION EARLY

Please contact the early termination supervisor of the Rhode Island Department of Corrections (RIDOC) Probation and Parole Unit at **401-462-2242** to review your file and be considered for eligibility. If you meet all of the criteria, you will be issued a certificate. Once you receive your certificate, you must follow the process in Rule 35(c) of the R.I. Rules of Criminal Procedure to request the Superior Court to end your probation early. If you have any questions you may also contact the Office of the Public Defender at **401-458-3050** or a private attorney. If applicable, RIDOC will make reasonable efforts to contact the victim(s) through its office of victim services and/or the last known address.



There are NO pending probation/deferred sentence revocation proceedings filed against you



You are currently NOT on parole in RI or any other jurisdiction



You are NOT the subject of pending charges in RI or any other jurisdiction



You are NOT on probation, serving a suspended sentence, or serving a deferred sentence in any other criminal case in RI or another jurisdiction
