



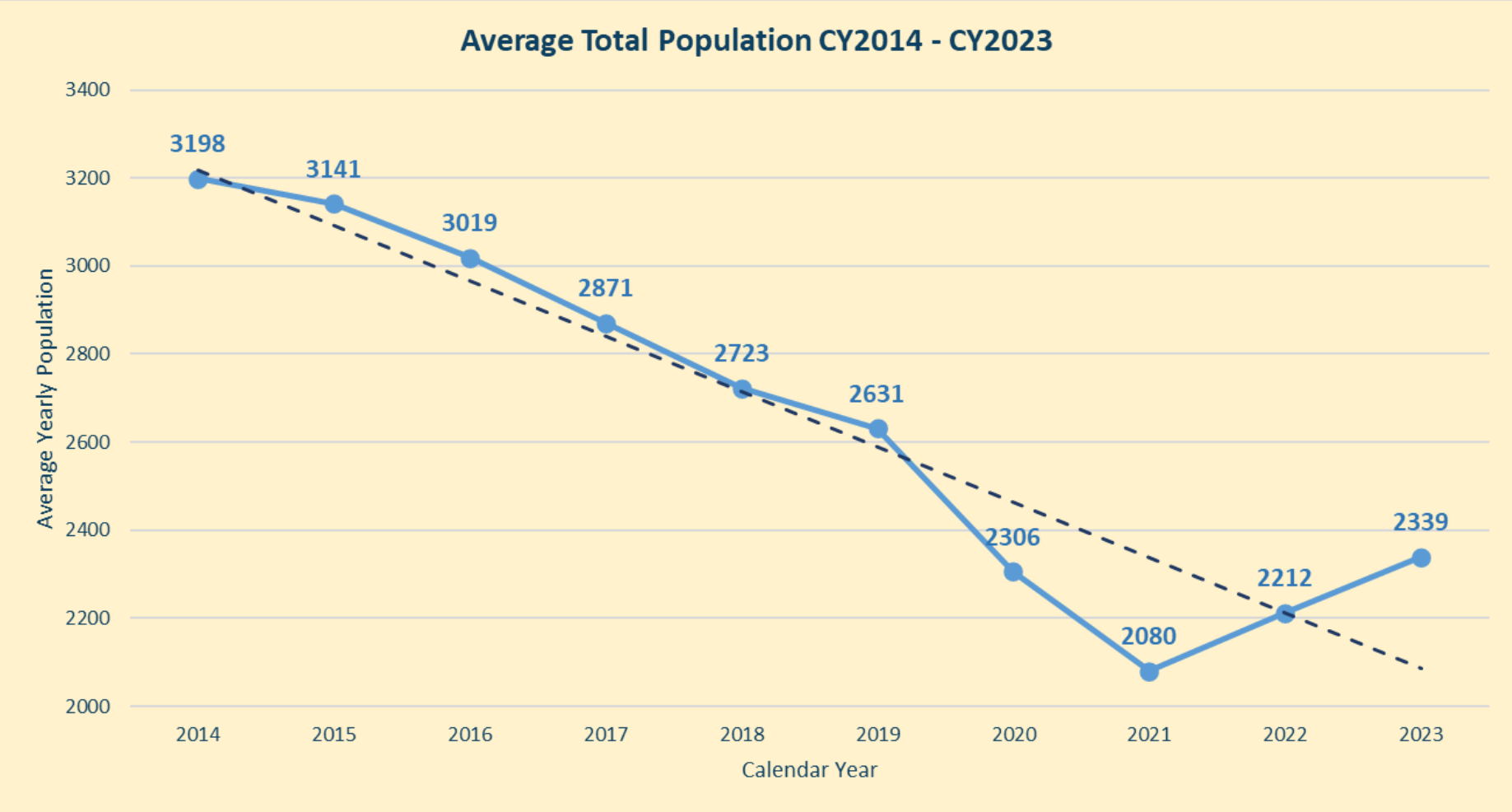

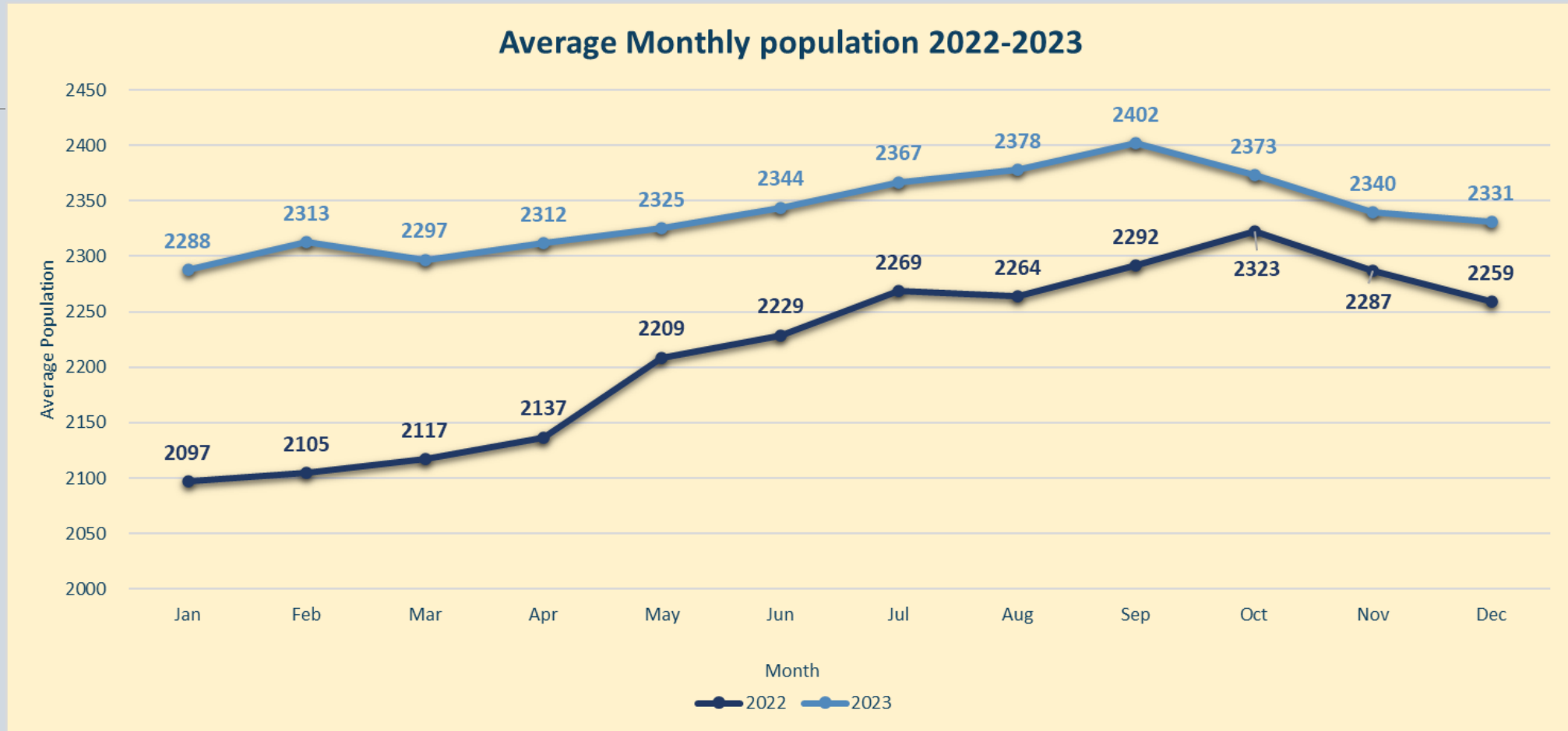
# Average Total Population CY2014-2023



RIDOC’s average total population in CY23 was 2,339, which was a 26.9% decrease from CY14’s population of 3,198.

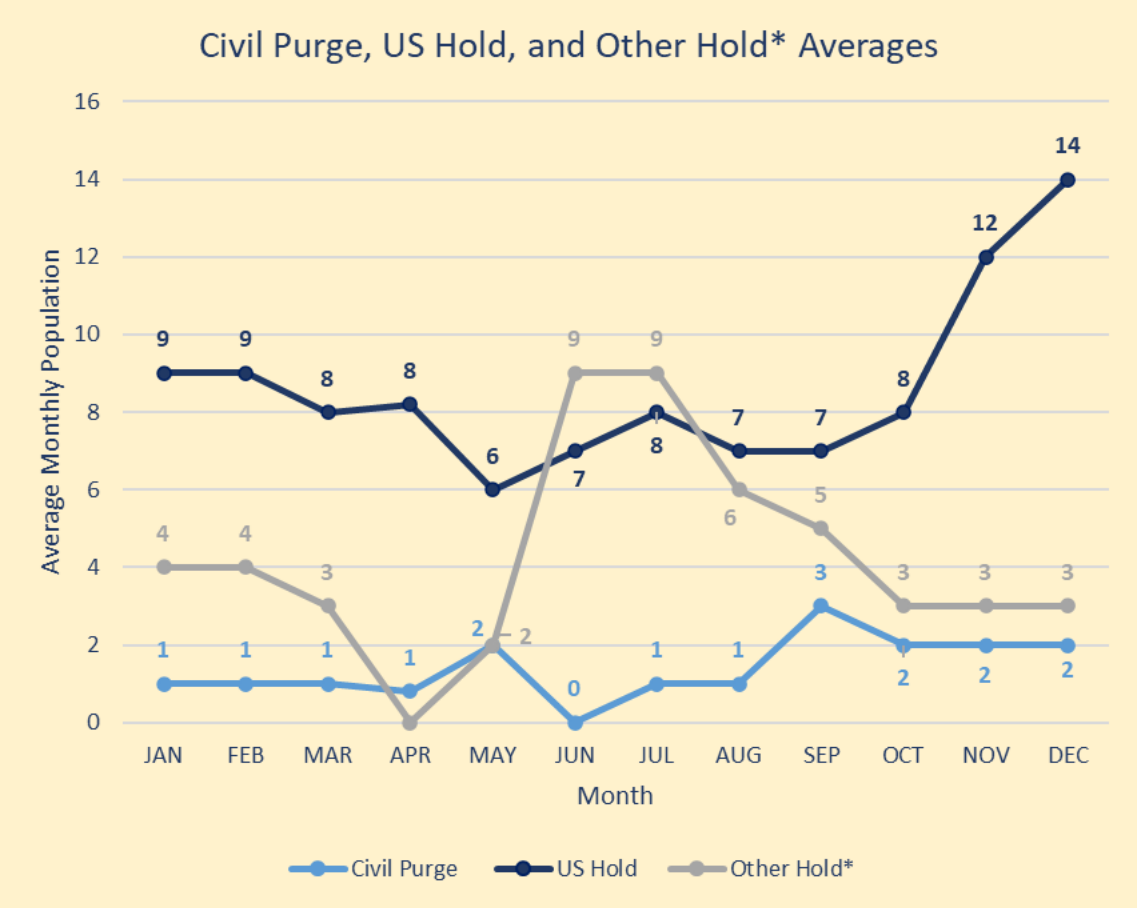
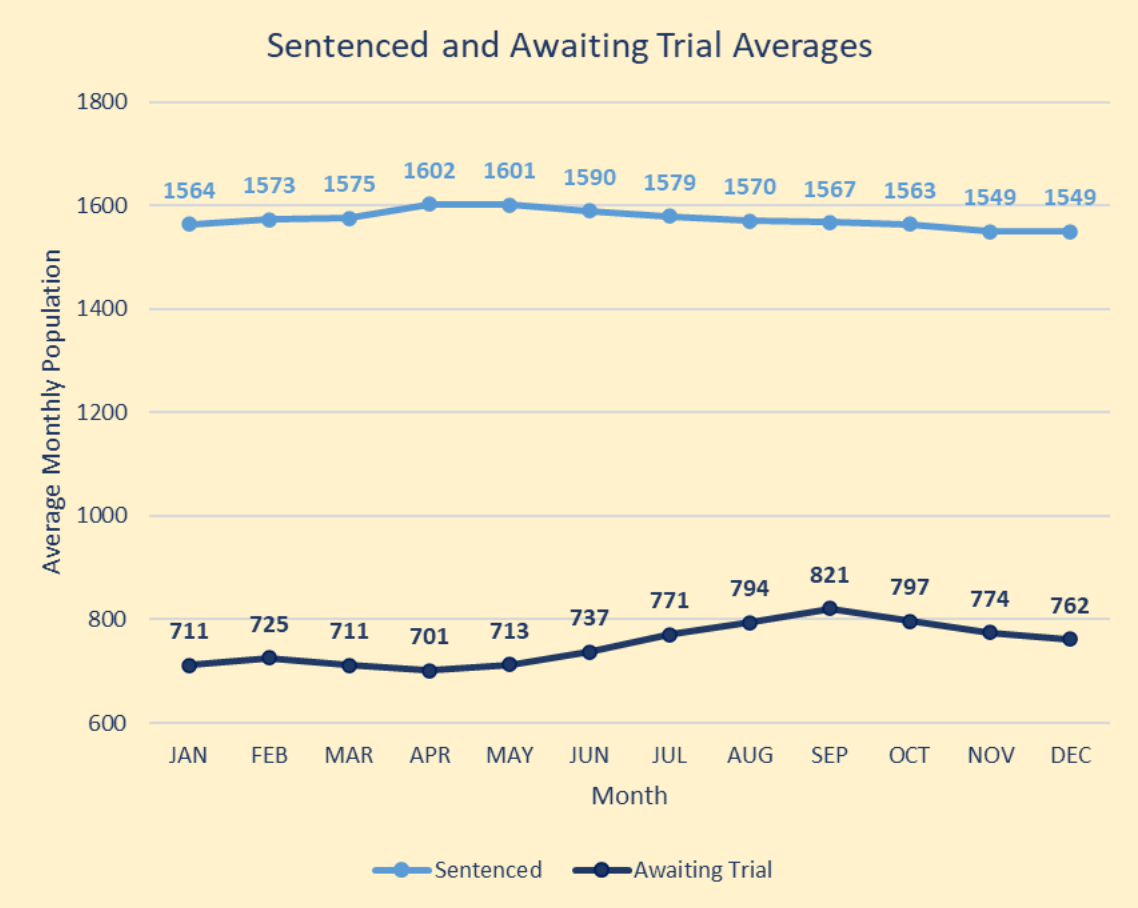
**Note:** RIDOC’s average total population excludes offenders who are serving a RI sentence out-of-state in accordance with the Interstate Compact, at the Eleanor Slater Hospital Forensic Unit, or on Home Confinement.

# Average Total Population by Month Calendar Years 2022-2023



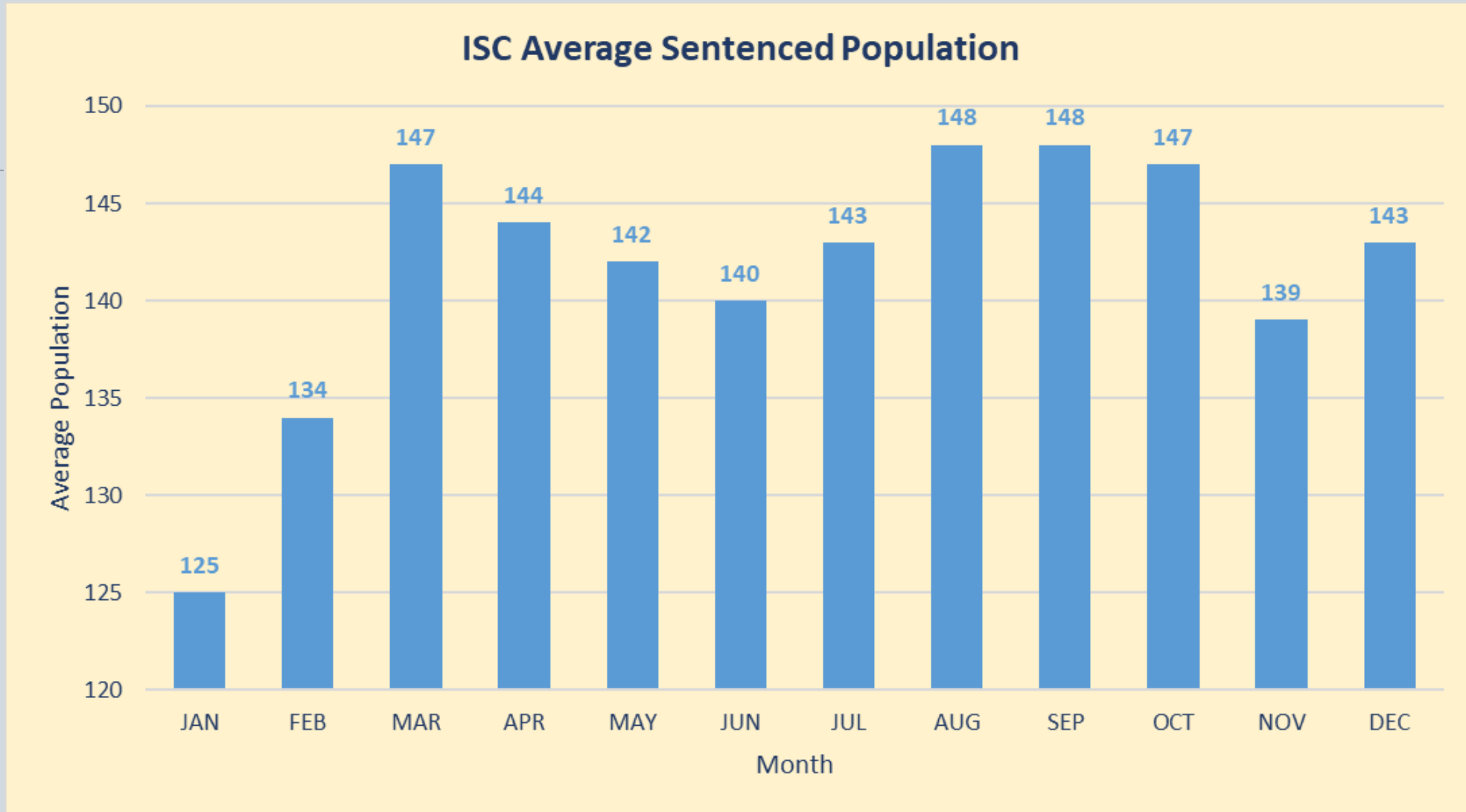
The average total monthly population in CY23 was higher in every month than it was in CY22. The average total population of CY23 (2,339) was 5.7% higher than CY22 (2,212).

# CY23 Average Sentenced, Awaiting Trial, Civil Purge, and Detainee Populations



**Note:** A "Civil Purge" includes those who are at the RIDOC under Rule 69 of the RI Superior Court Rules of Civil Procedure which allows for a period of incarceration to be ordered by the court for refusal or willful failure to comply with a payment decree. "Other Hold" includes holds for other states and holds for military.

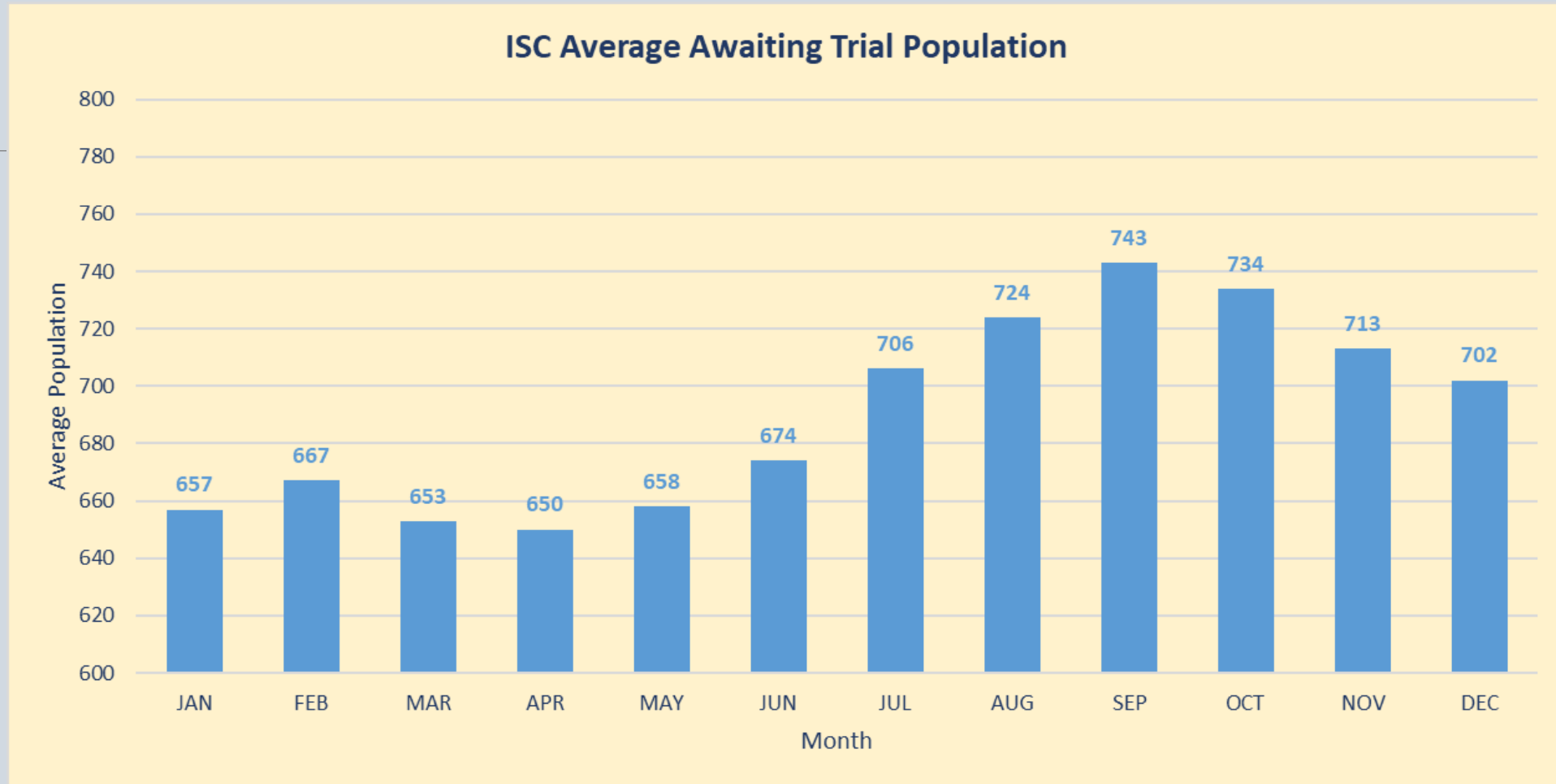
## Average Monthly Sentenced Population at Intake Service Center (ISC) Calendar Year 2023



In CY23, the average length of stay (LOS) for all sentenced release events from RIDOC's Intake Service Center was just over 71 days. The median LOS was 35 days. Nearly 61% of sentenced releases had a LOS of 45 days or less. An additional 16% had an LOS of 46 to 60 days. 11% of sentenced releases had a LOS of 61- 90 days and 12% had a LOS of 91+ days.

**Note:** The median is the middle number in a sorted data set.

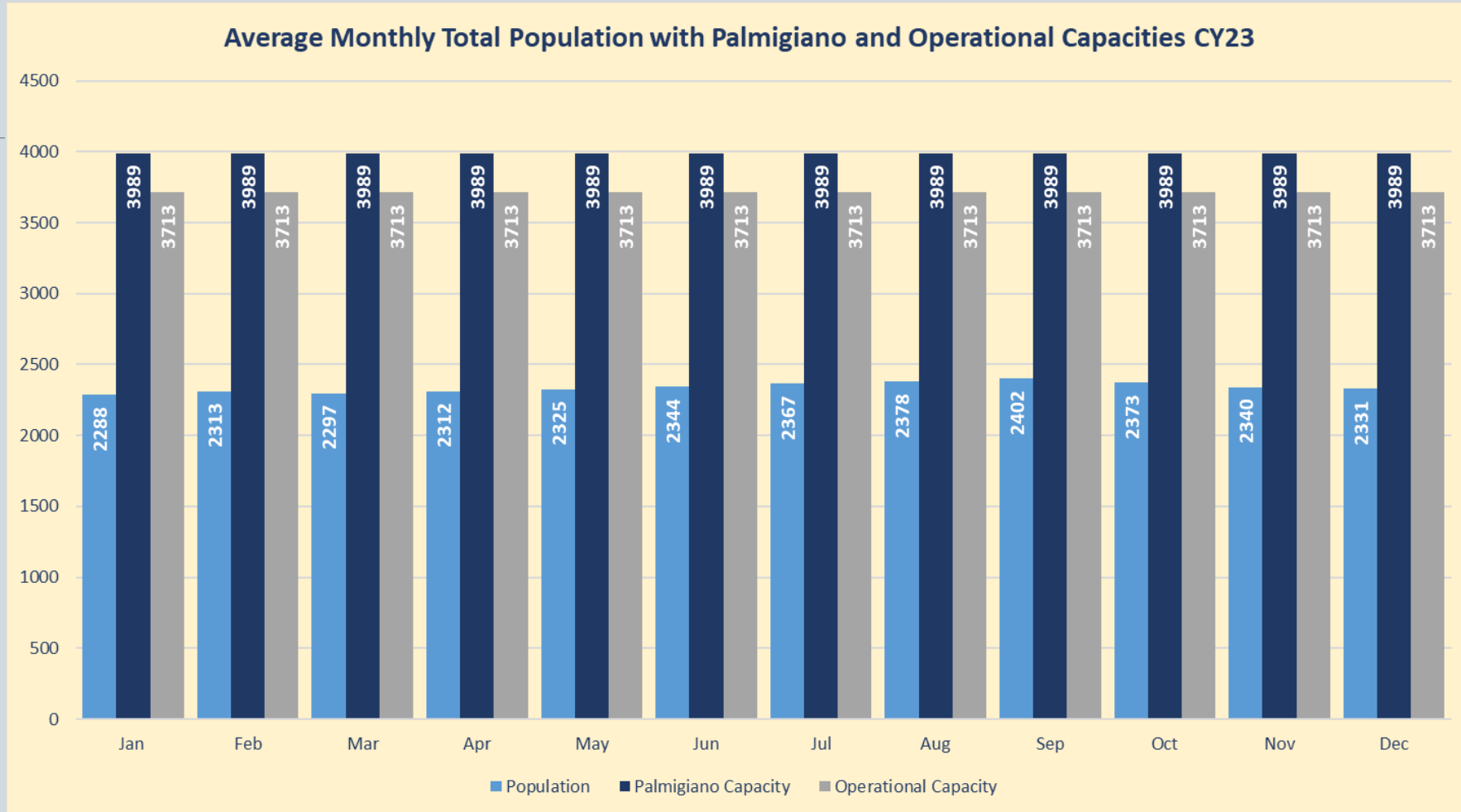
## Average Monthly Awaiting Trial Population at Intake Service Center (ISC) Calendar Year 2023



In CY23, the average awaiting trial population at ISC had slight fluctuations from January (657) through May (658) before steadily increasing by 13% from May to September (743). From September through the end of the year there was a decrease of 5.5%. Awaiting trial releases from ISC had an average length of stay (LOS) of about 29.1 days, with a median LOS of 5 days. Nearly 14% were committed and released on the same day and 47% of awaiting trial releases had a LOS of 3 days or less. An additional 4% had a LOS of between 4 and 7 days. About 78% of awaiting trial releases had a LOS of 30 days or less.

**Note:** The awaiting trial population does not include civil, U.S., or other holds.

# Average Monthly Total Population with Palmigiano and Operational Capacities CY23

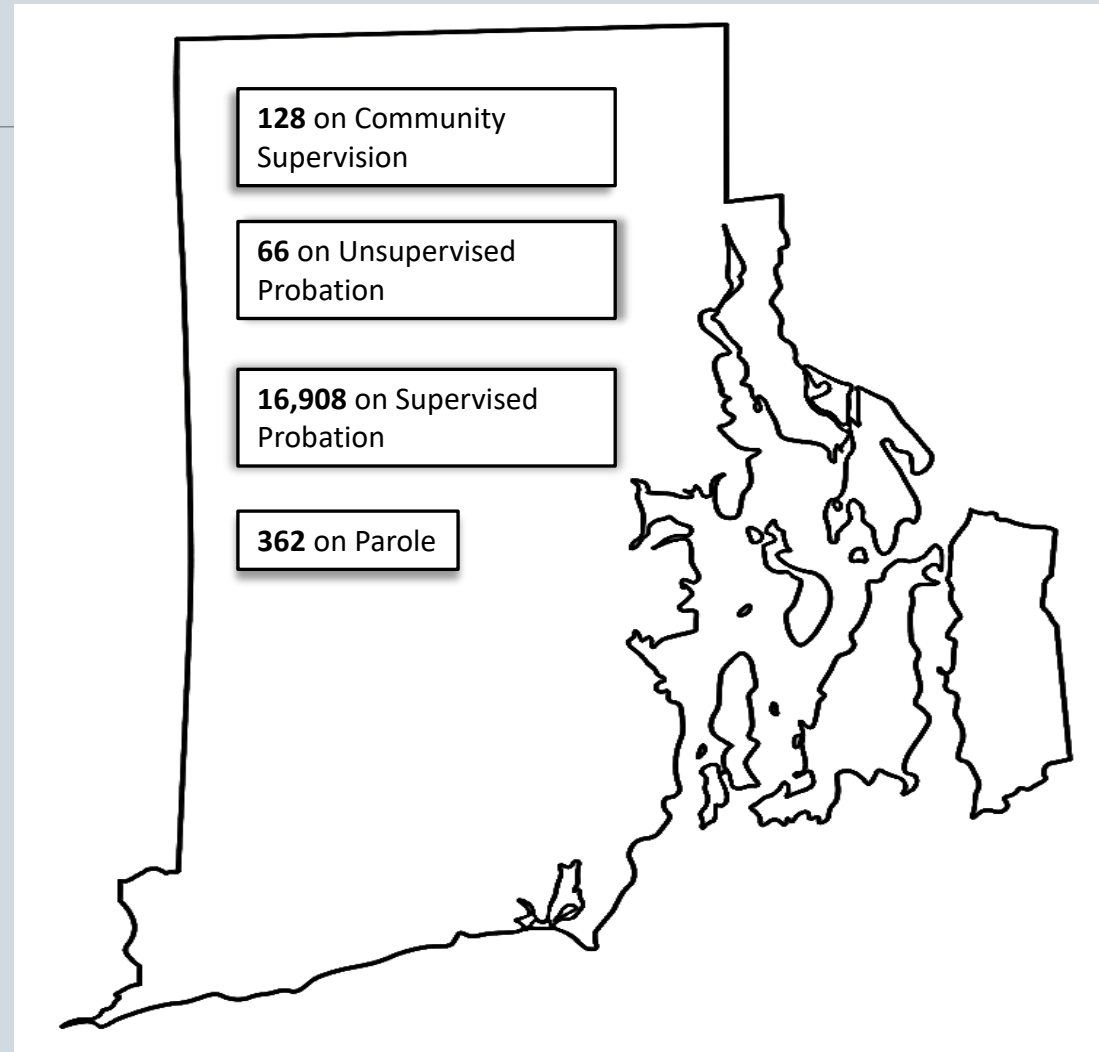


The average total population for CY22 was 2,339. This is 58.6% of the Palmigiano Capacity and 63% of the Operational Capacity.

**Note:** Palmigiano Capacity refers to the capacity established in federal court which mandates the number of offenders that RIDOC can safely detain. RIDOC's Palmigiano Capacity is calculated with a formula that utilizes the total number of available beds.

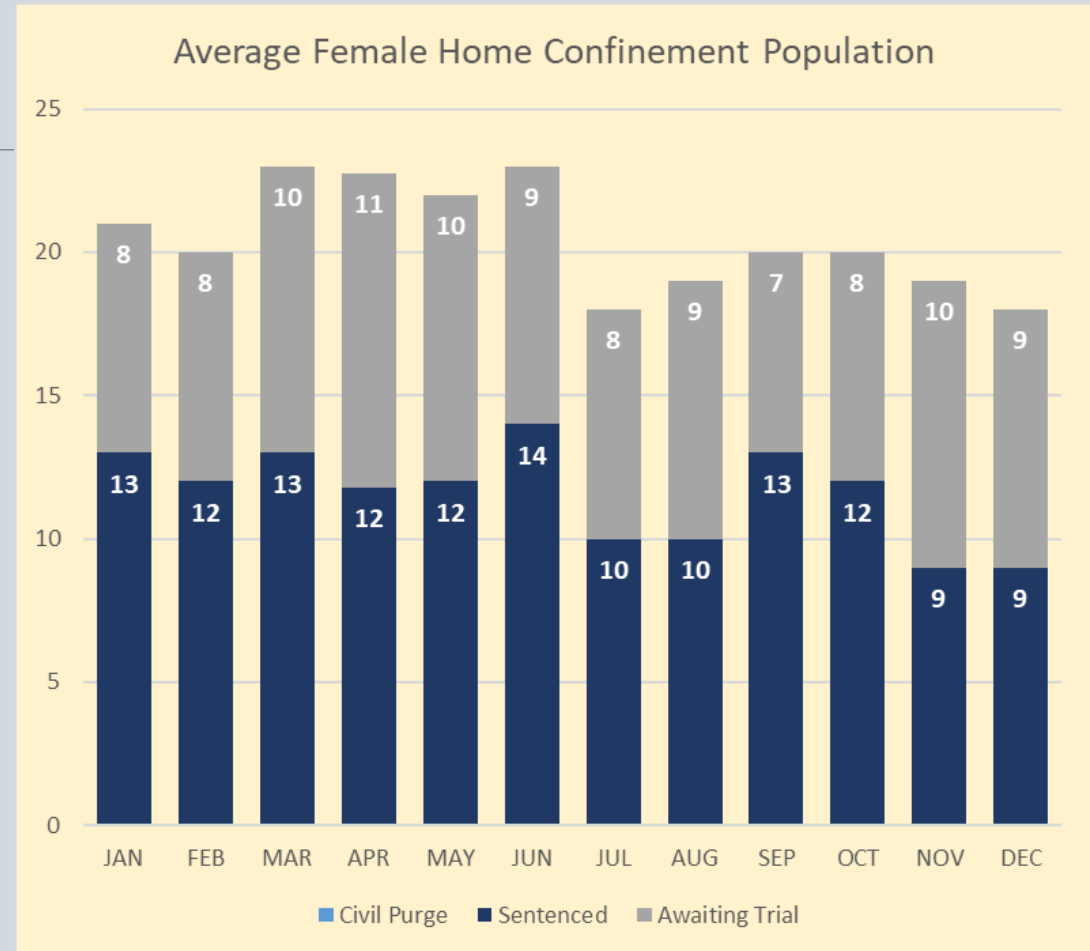
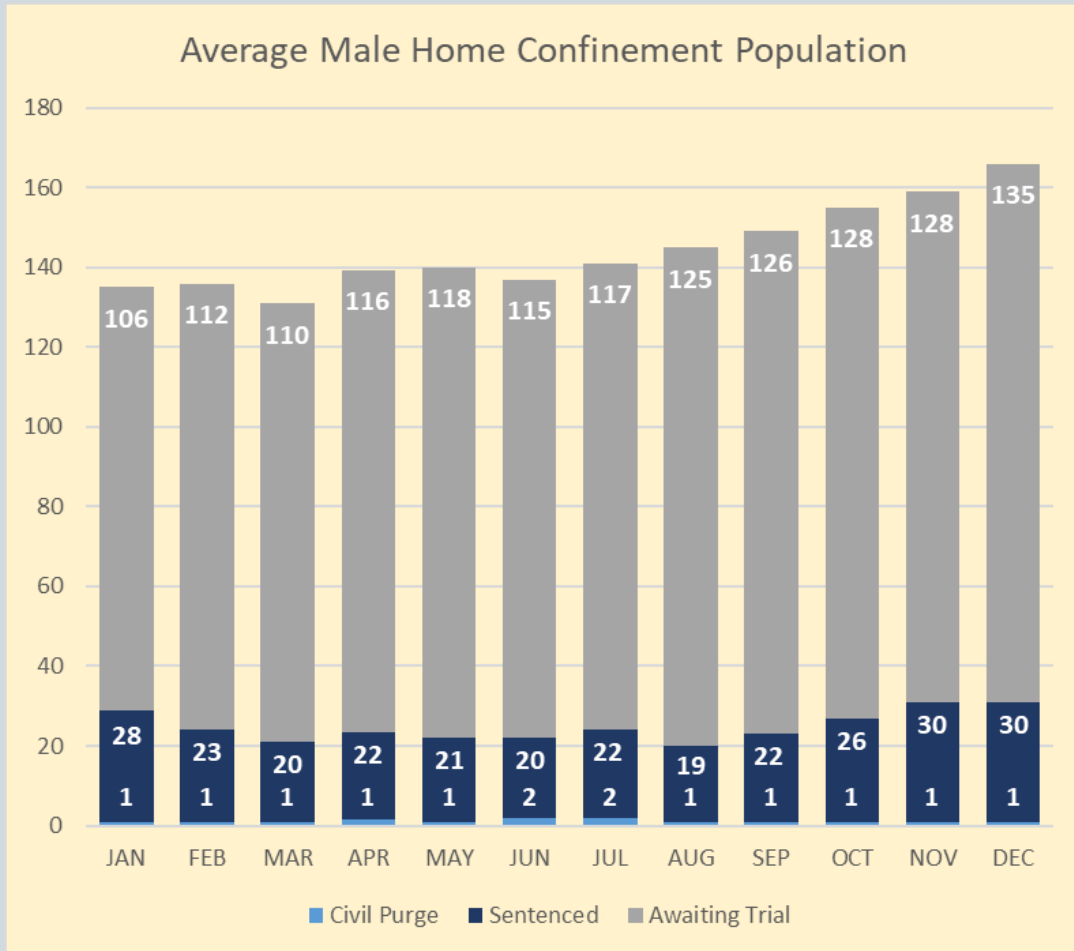
Operational Capacity refers to the number of individuals that RIDOC can safely accommodate based on a facility's staff, existing programs, and services. RIDOC's Operational Capacity is calculated utilizing the following formula: All Beds—(Hospital Beds + 1/3 of Segregation Beds).

# Individuals Serving a Life Sentence at RIDOC

## **As of December 31, 2023:**

193 individuals were serving life with the possibility of parole in RIDOC facilities.

### **Out of the 193:**

44% were housed at Maximum Security

38% were housed at Medium Security

11% were housed at High Security

4% were housed at Intake

2% were housed at Women's

1% were housed at Minimum

## **As of December 31, 2023:**

25 individuals serving life without parole in RIDOC facilities.

### **Out of the 25:**

88% were housed at Maximum Security

8% were housed at Medium Security

4% were housed at High Security
