

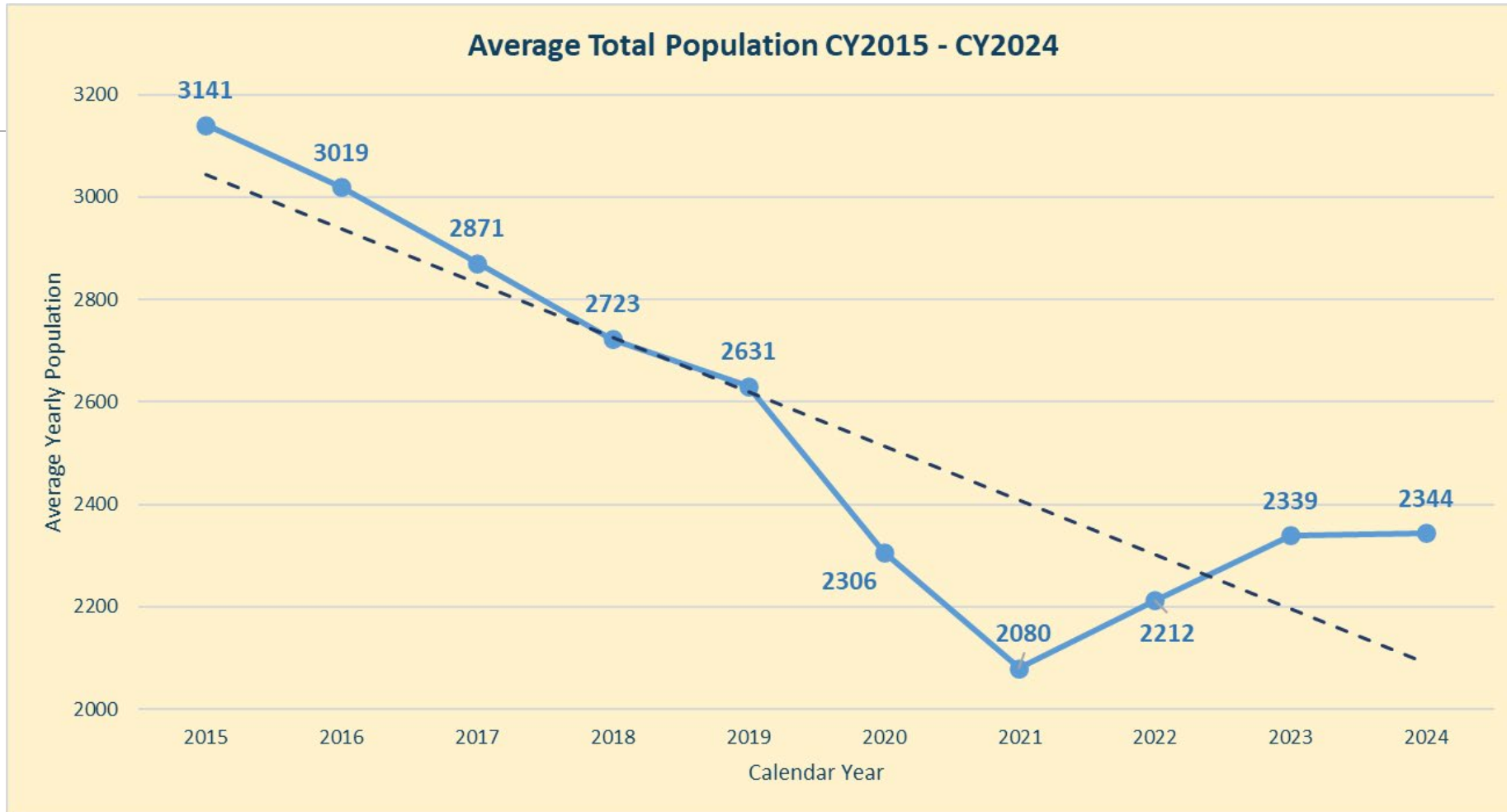

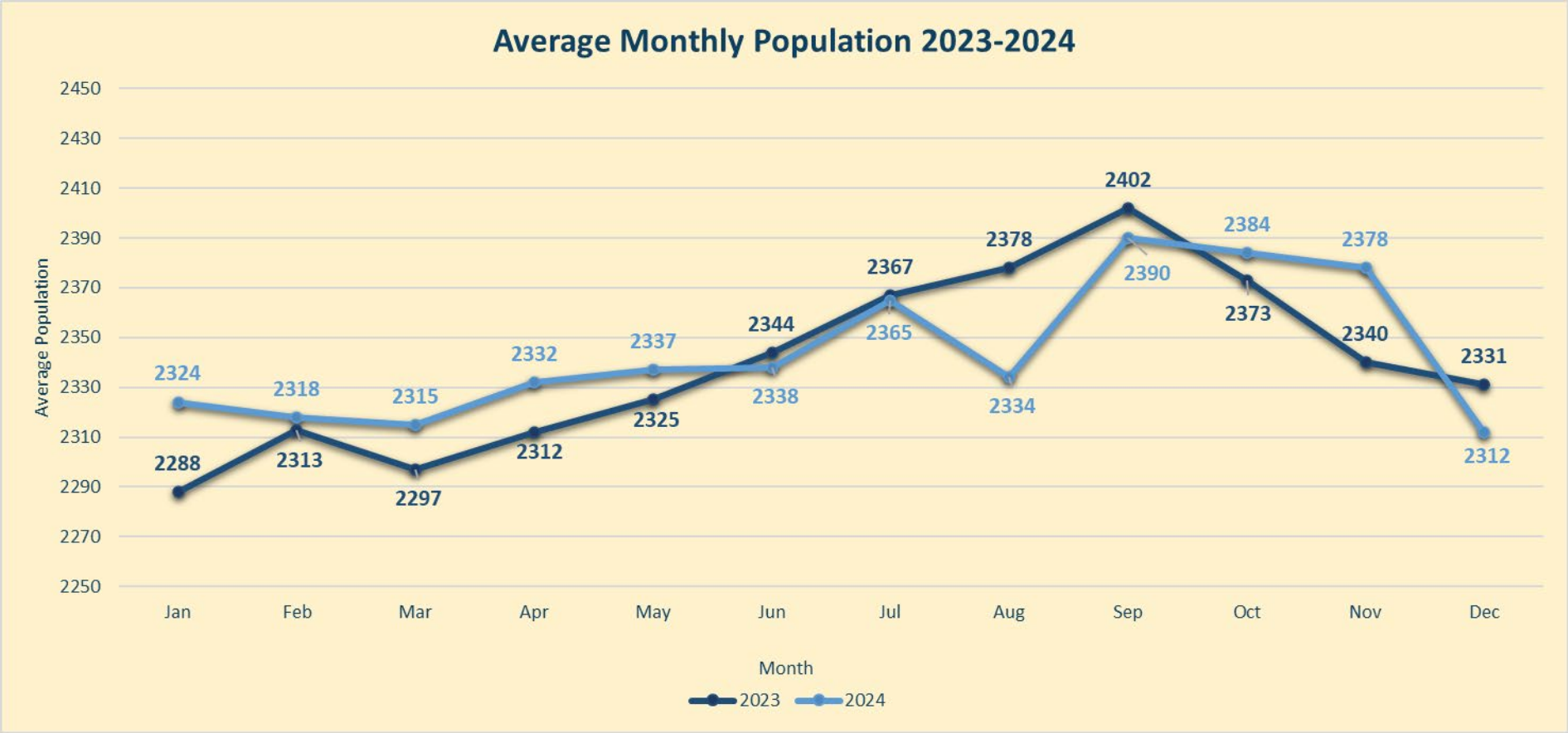
Average Total Population CY2015-2024



RIDOC's average total population in CY24 was 2,344, which was a 25.4% decrease from CY15's population of 3,141 and a 0.2% increase from 2023.

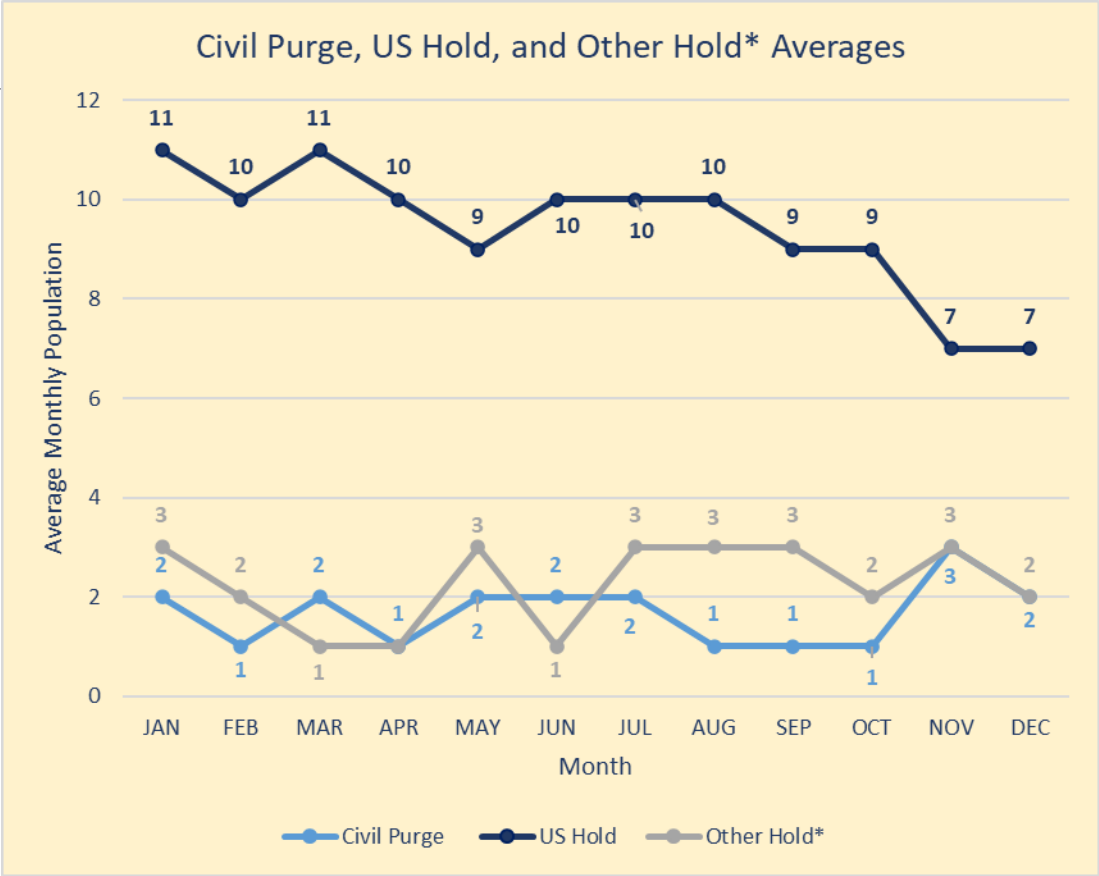
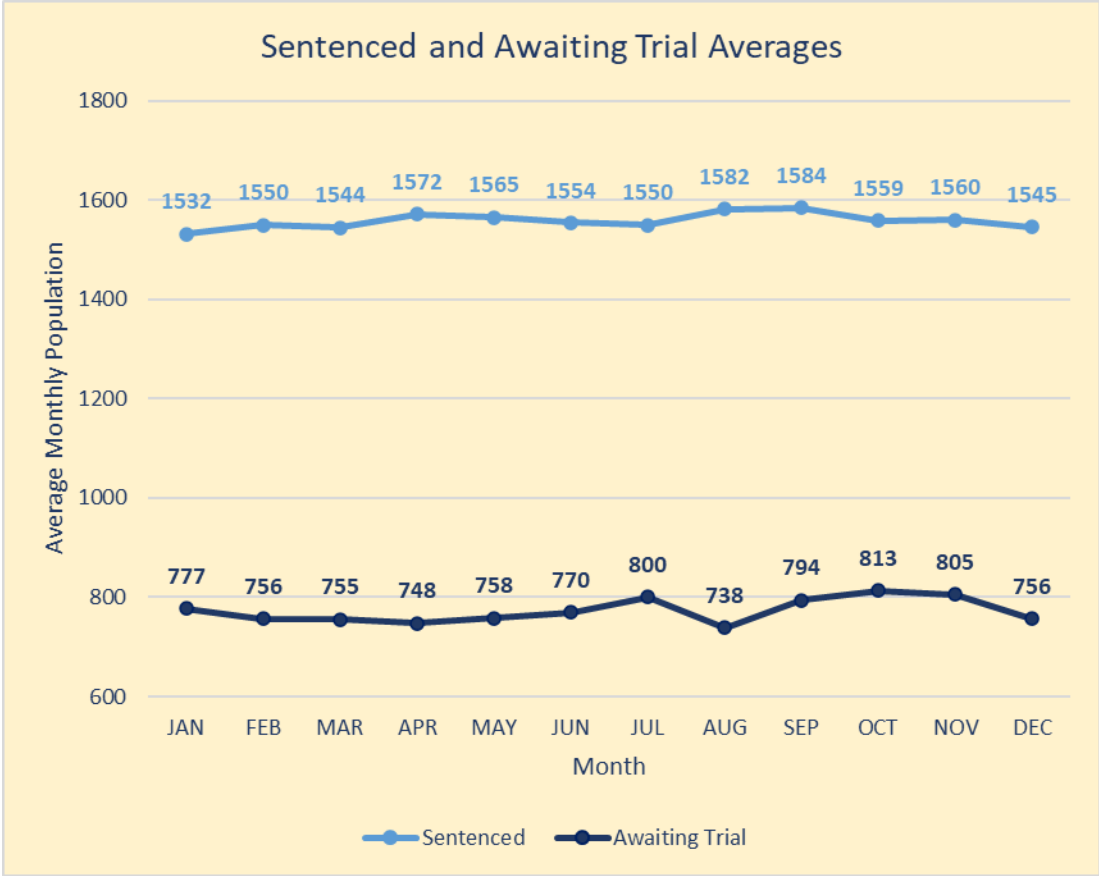
Note: RIDOC's average total population excludes offenders who are serving a RI sentence out-of-state in accordance with the Interstate Compact, at the Eleanor Slater Hospital Forensic Unit, or on Home Confinement.

Average Total Population by Month Calendar Years 2023-2024



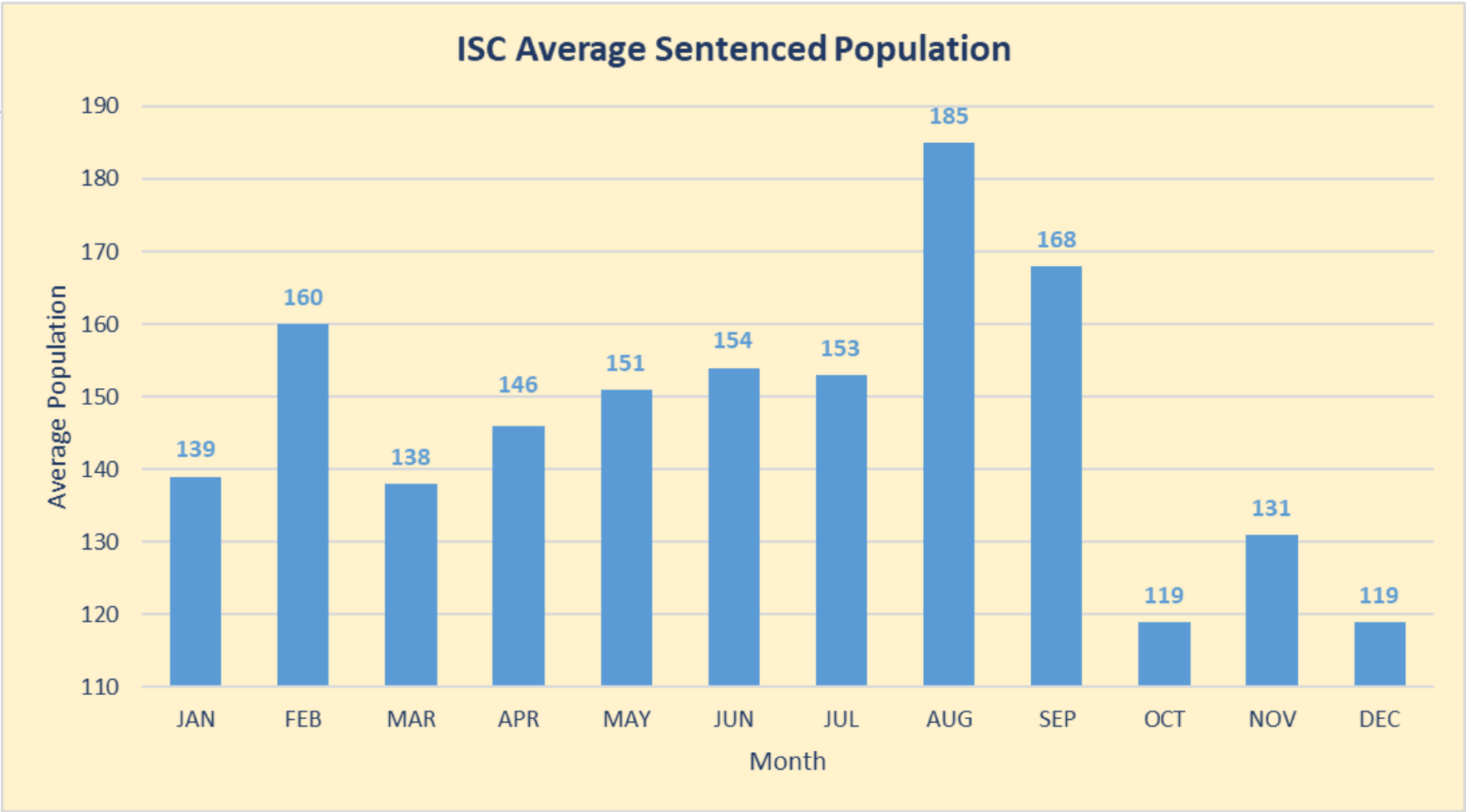
The average total monthly population in CY24 was higher than CY23 from January through May. During the summer months of CY24, the population dipped compared to CY23 but went back up in the fall. In December, the monthly average of CY24 fell back below that of CY23. The average total population of CY24 (2,344) was 0.2% higher than CY23 (2,339).

Note: A “Civil Purge” includes those who are at the RIDOC under Rule 69 of the RI Superior Court Rules of Civil Procedure which allows for a period of incarceration to be ordered by the court for refusal or willful failure to comply with a payment decree. “Other Hold” includes holds for other states and holds for military.

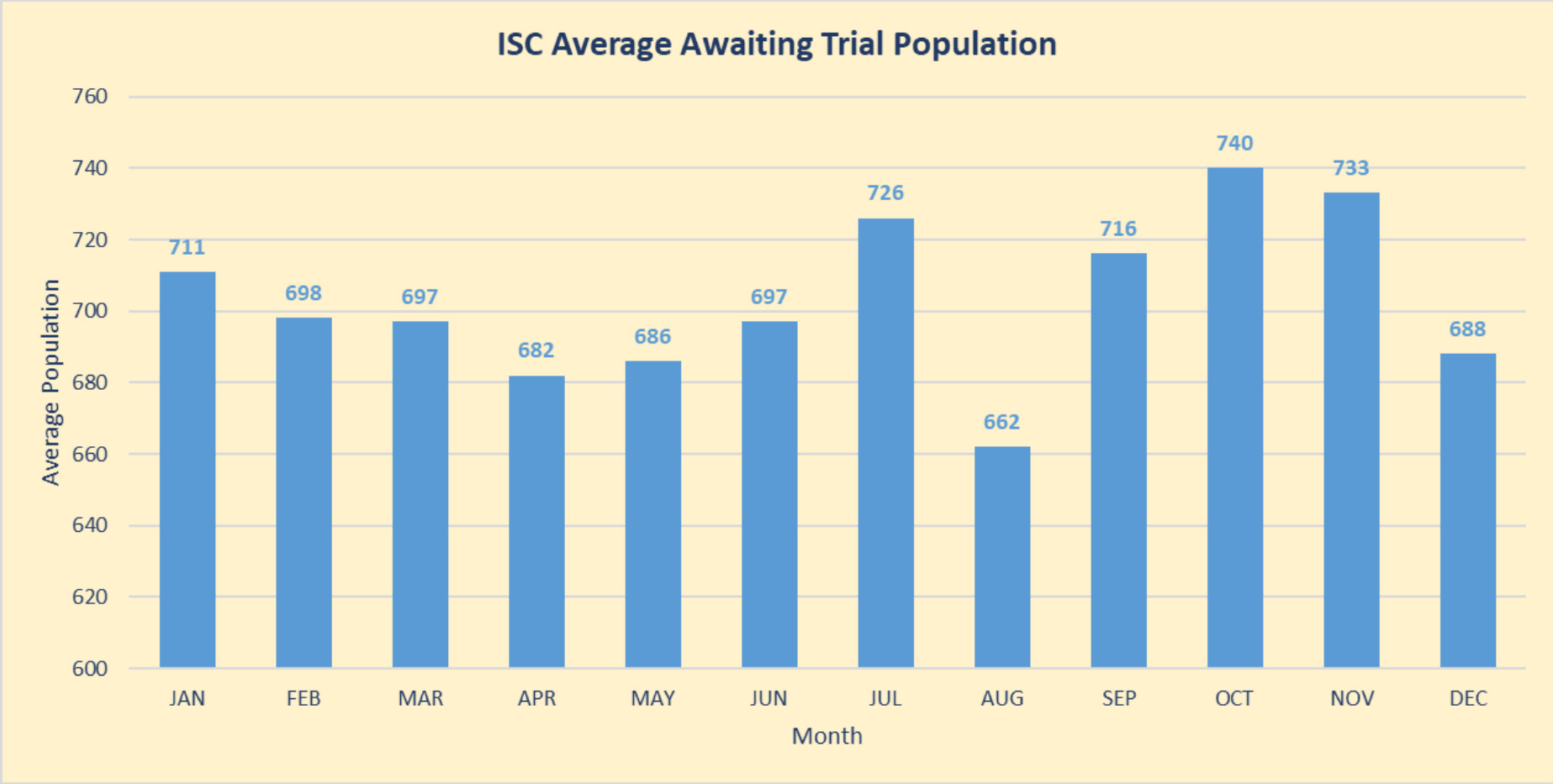
Average Monthly Sentenced Population at Intake Service Center (ISC) Calendar Year 2024



In CY24, the average length of stay (LOS) for all sentenced release events from RIDOC’s Intake Service Center was just over 71 days. The median LOS was 35 days. 62% of sentenced releases had a LOS of 45 days or less. An additional 13% had an LOS of 46 to 60 days. 11% of sentenced releases had a LOS of 61-90 days and nearly 14% had a LOS of 91+ days.

Note: The median is the middle number in a sorted data set.

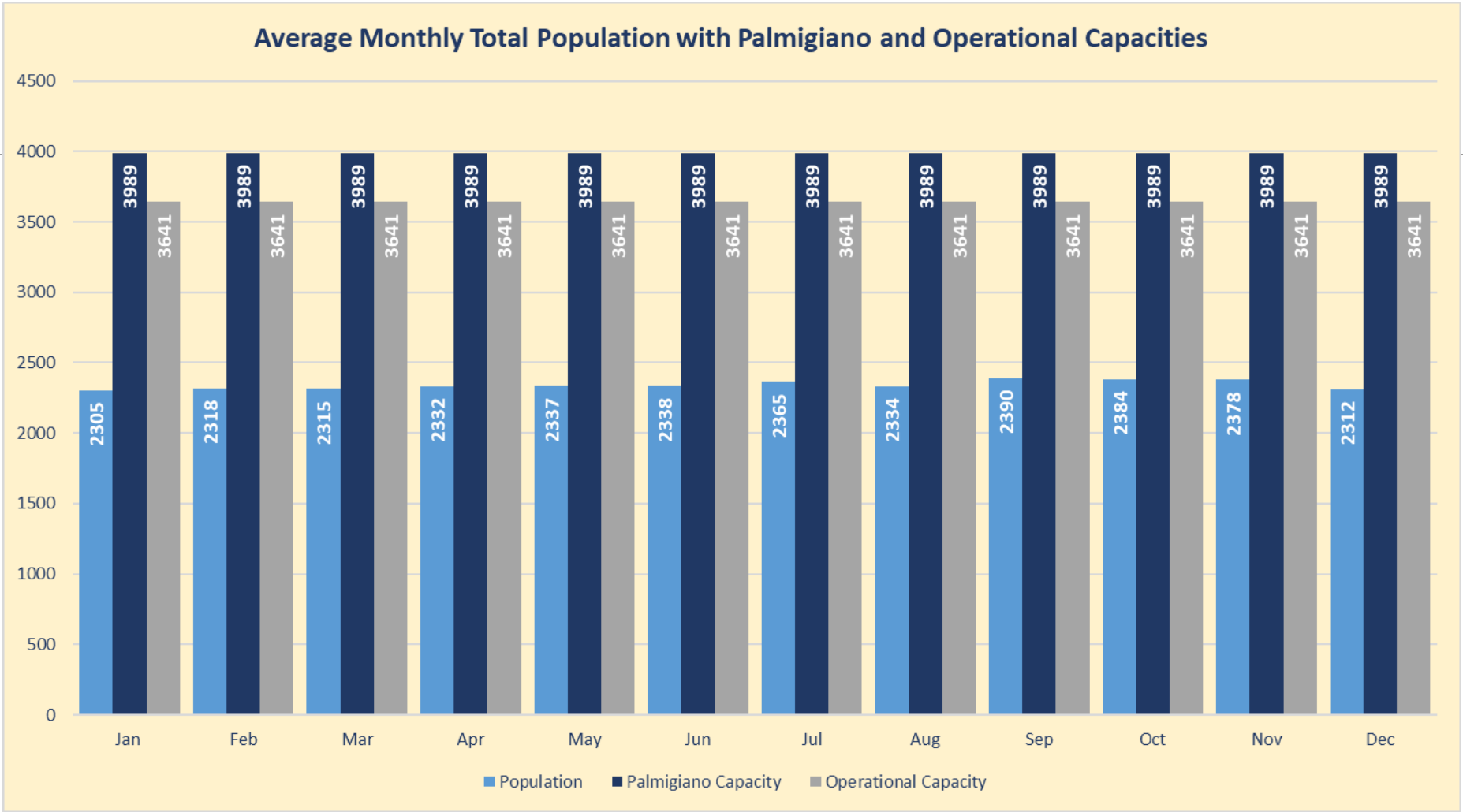
Average Monthly Awaiting Trial Population at Intake Service Center (ISC) Calendar Year 2024



In CY24, the average awaiting trial population at ISC fell 4.0% from January (711) through April (682) before steadily increasing by 6.5% through July (743). The population fell 8.8% in August (662) before rising 11.8% to its peak in October (740). It then fell 7.0% and ended the year at 688. Awaiting trial releases from ISC had an average length of stay (LOS) of about 34 days, with a median LOS of 5 days. About 13.0% were committed and released on the same day and 46.0% of awaiting trial releases had a LOS of 3 days or less. An additional 5.0% had a LOS of between 4 and 7 days. Seventy-six percent (76.0%) of awaiting trial releases had a LOS of 30 days or less.

Note: The awaiting trial population does not include civil, U.S., or other holds.

Average Monthly Total Population with Palmigiano and Operational Capacities CY24

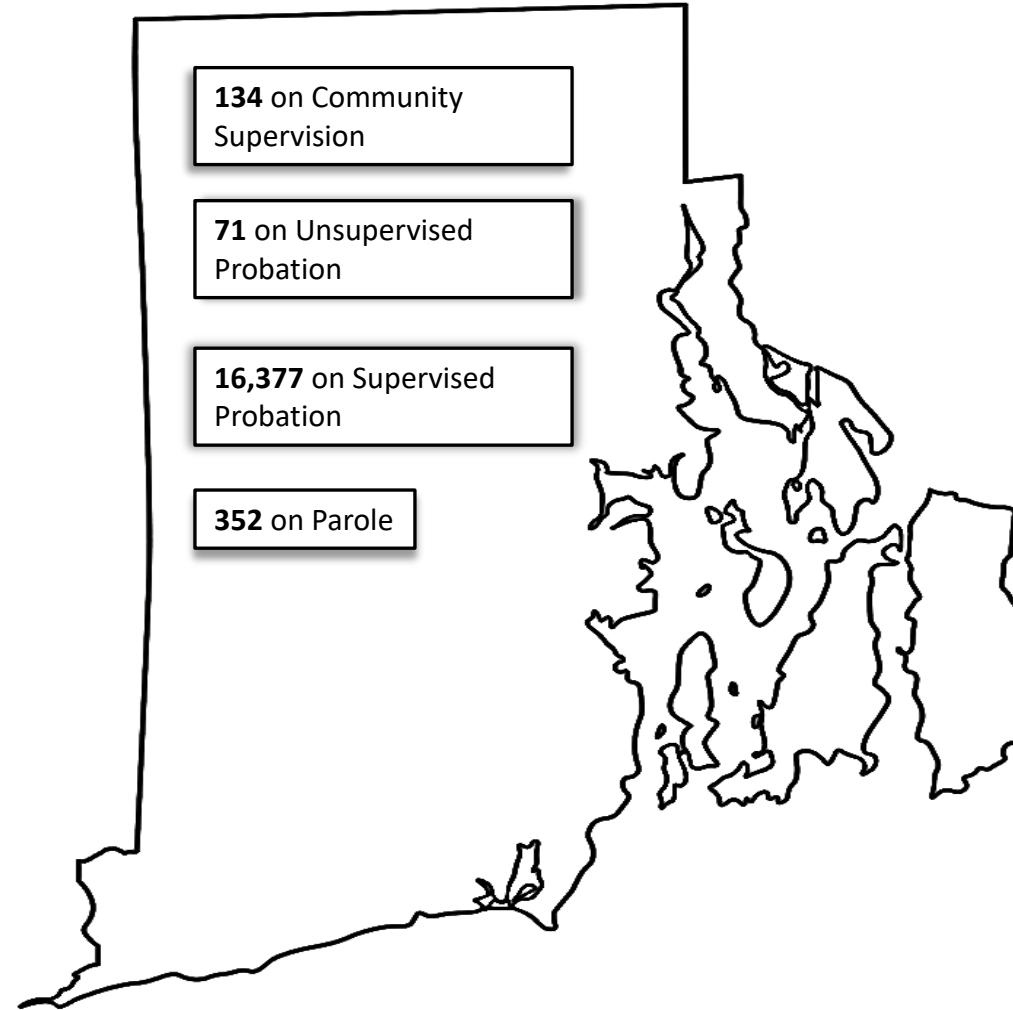


The average total population for CY24 was 2,344. This is 58.8% of the Palmigiano Capacity and 64.0% of the Operational Capacity.

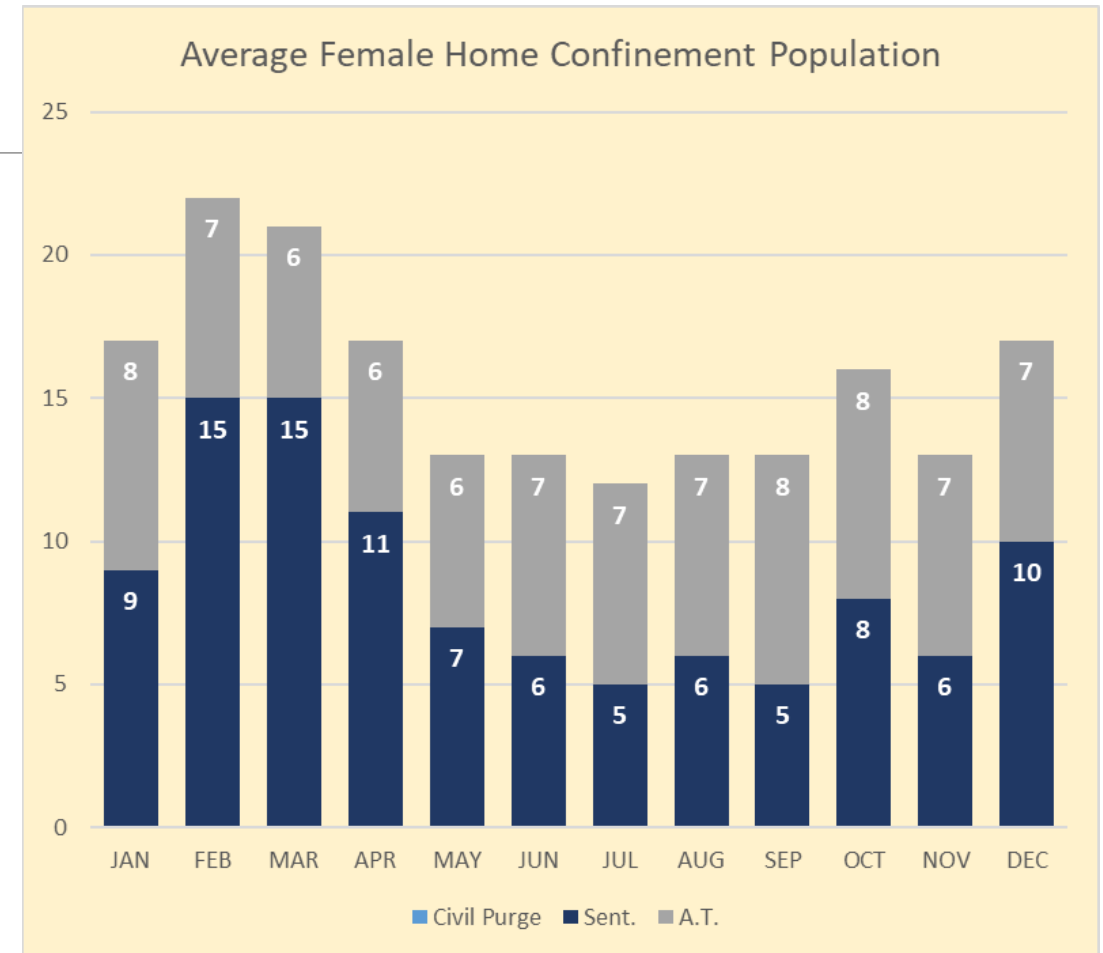
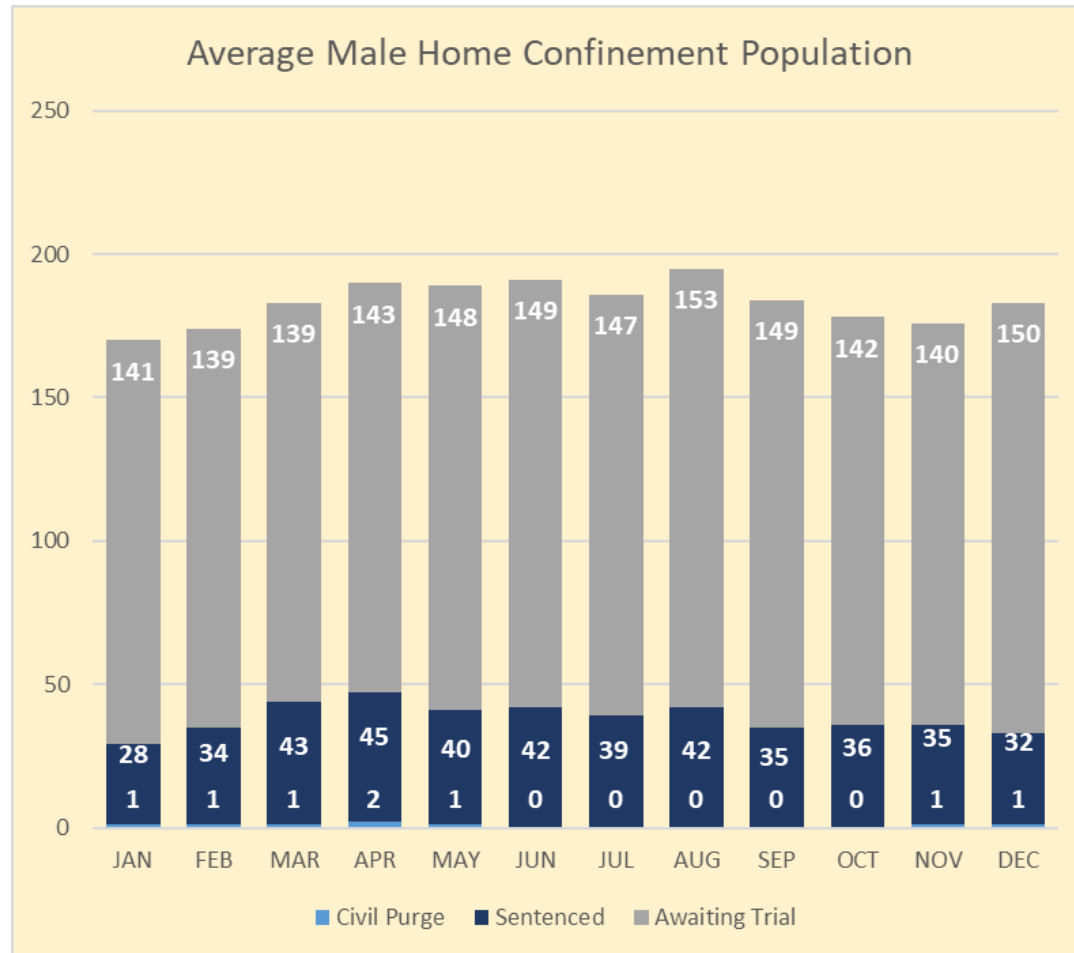
Note: Palmigiano Capacity refers to the capacity established in federal court which mandates the number of offenders that RIDOC can safely detain. RIDOC’s Palmigiano Capacity is calculated with a formula that utilizes the total number of available beds.

Operational Capacity refers to the number of individuals that RIDOC can safely accommodate based on a facility’s staff, existing programs, and services. RIDOC’s Operational Capacity is calculated utilizing the following formula: All Beds—(Hospital Beds + 1/3 of Segregation Beds).

In CY24, the average number of males on home confinement was 183 and the average number of females was 16.

Individuals Serving a Life Sentence at RIDOC

As of December 31, 2024:

202 individuals were serving life with the possibility of parole in RIDOC facilities.

Out of the 202:

46% were housed at Maximum Security

39% were housed at Medium Security

12% were housed at High Security

2% were housed at Women's

>1% were housed at Intake

>1% were housed at Minimum

As of December 31, 2024:

25 individuals serving life without parole in RIDOC facilities.

Out of the 25:

84% were housed at Maximum Security

12% were housed at Medium Security

4% were housed at High Security
